

Saint Philip Neri School - Urgent Request

The following clearances must be on file (copies of each of the certificates) at school and in the parish office before anyone can volunteer in school, help in any way in any classroom/library/computer lab, supervise students during lunch in the cafeteria or in the recess yard, or to be a chaperon on a class trip or school sponsored activity. Parents should retain the original copies and school will make the necessary copies for our records. The required clearances are as follows:

- 1) **Safe Environment** (also called VIRTUS) – This is a 2.5 – 3 hour presentation by the Archdiocesan office that oversees the clearances. *(There is one scheduled here at St. Philip Neri on the evening of October 3rd beginning at 6:30 PM – imperative to be present for the entire presentation).* A list of other places for these presentations can also be found on the Archdiocesan website. You will receive a certificate upon completion of the presentation that evening. No cost. This is a 'once and done'.

- 2) **Criminal Check** – This is one that can be completed online using a credit card and the results are immediate. Please print out more than 1 certificate as one original certificate must be sent to Harrisburg to receive the Child Abuse certificate. This clearance must be updated

every 5 years. Cost - \$10.

- 3) **Child Abuse Check** – This form can be downloaded from the Harrisburg website. Fill it out and mail it with an original copy of your Criminal Check. The Child Abuse check will be mailed to you. This clearance must be updated every 5 years. Cost - \$10

- 4) **Mandated Reporter** – This also comes from the Archdiocesan office that does Safe Environment. You will receive a certificate upon completion of the presentation. More information will be coming as none of these sessions are scheduled at this time but will be shortly. As of now this is also a 'once and done'. No cost

Thank you for your cooperation with these Archdiocesan required checks. We look forward to having you work with us in school once all of the clearances are on file.

PARISH RELIGIOUS EDUCATION PROGRAM

REGISTRATION for the Parish Religious Education Program (CCD) is now being finalized. Books and materials need to be ordered. The cost of the program is \$175.00 for one child and \$225 for two or more children. If you only have one or more children in Kindergarten, the cost is \$100. Kindergarten classes are on Sunday mornings from 10:00-10:50 AM. Grades 1 through 6 have their classes on Monday and Tuesday afternoons from 4:00-5:00 PM. Bus transportation is available from Whitemarsh Elementary, Ridge Park and Colonial Elementary both days for \$50 per family. A child needs to attend only one class per week. The day of choice will be limited to the number of children who can ride the bus meeting a safe and legal limit.
