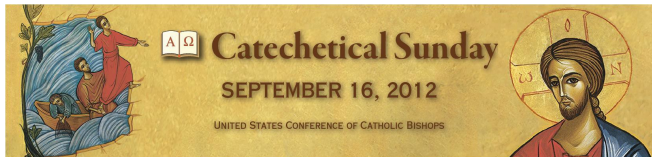

The following clearances must be on file (copies of each of the certificates) at school and in the parish office before anyone can volunteer in school, help in any way in any

classroom/library/computer lab, supervise students during lunch in the cafeteria or in the recess yard, or to be a chaperon on a class trip or school sponsored activity. Parents should retain the original copies and school will make the necessary copies for our records. The required clearances are as follows:

- 1) Safe Environment No cost. This is a 'once and done'.

- 2) Criminal Check –Cost - \$10.

- 3) Child Abuse Check – This form can be downloaded from the Harrisburg website. Fill it out and mail it with an original copy of your Criminal Check. The Child Abuse check will be mailed to you. This clearance must be updated every 5 years. Cost - \$10.

- 4) Mandated Reporter – This also comes from the Archdiocesan office that does Safe Environment. No cost. **Thank you for your cooperation with these Archdiocesan required checks. We look forward to having you work with us in school once all of the clearances are on file.**

The Seven Churches Pilgrimage in Philadelphia
On Saturday, October 13, 2012, the Secular Oratory of Philadelphia (Oratorians) is sponsoring a Seven Churches Pilgrimage, a tradition started by the patron of our parish, St. Philip Neri. This walking pilgrimage includes visits to Saint Francis Xavier Church, the Cathedral Basilica of Saints Peter and Paul, Saint John the Evangelist Church, Old Saint Mary's Church, Old Saint Joseph's Church, Saint Peter the Apostle Church (home to the National Shrine of St. John Neumann), the Ukrainian Catholic Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception, and the Chapel of Divine Love (home of the Pink Sisters).
