PARISH RELIGIOUS EDUCATION PROGRAM

REGISTRATION for the Parish Religious Education Program (CCD) is now being taken for 2013-2014. Those registered at Saint Philip's with an incoming child in Kindergarten and Grade 1 already received a letter and registration form. Those currently enrolled have already received their materials. The cost of the program is \$175 for one child and \$225 for 2 or more children. If you only have one or more children in Kindergarten, the cost is \$100. Kindergarten classes are on Sunday mornings from 10:00-10:50 AM. Grades 1-6 have classes on Monday and Tuesday afternoons from 4:00-5:30 PM. Bus transportation is available from Whitemarsh

Elementary, Ridge Park, and Colonial Elementary both days for \$50 per family. A child needs to attend only one class per week. The day of choice will be limited to the number of children who can ride the bus meeting a safe and legal limit. If you like children, have faith in God, and would like to get involved at Saint Philip's we will supply you with catechetical training, teaching manuals, and resources. St. Genevieve Parish Seminar – June 25 at 7:30pm The US Conference of Catholic Bishops has declared a 2nd Fortnight For Freedom from June 21 to July 4. This comes at a crucial time in the history of the US Church. On Aug 1 the HHS mandate takes effect. That mandate requires employers to provide insurance coverage for medicinal abortions, sterilization and artificial contraception. The mandate grants a limited exception for some "religious institutions" but then proceeds to re-define what is a "religious institution" in a way that excludes Catholic Charities, Social Services, schools, colleges & hospitals as religious institutions. This is not a partisan issue. Learn the facts. The Church is counting on the laity to get informed and speak out. Articles of Faith: Our next Year of Faith meeting is Sunday, July 7th at 7:00 in the school library. We are studying the 9th Article of Faith of the Creed, "I believe in one Holy, Catholic, and Apostolic Church.". We will study this by

reviewing the Bible and Catechism and by viewing and discussing Lesson 6 of the DVD Series, Catholicism, by Father Robert Barron," A Body Both Suffering and Glorious: The Mystical Union of Christ and the Church." The Church, the Creed states, is "one, holy, catholic, and apostolic." These four characteristics, remarks the CCC, are, "inseparately linked with each other, indicate essential features of the Church and her mission. We will reflect on these four marks in light of what we have already considered regarding the faith..
