renowned priest and author, respected professor and beloved pastor. Henri Nouwen wrote over 40 books on the spiritual life. Nouwen's books have sold over 2 million copies and been published in over 22 languages In the final year before his death, Nouwen, began to write an account of the death of his friend Adam, a severely handicapped young man from the L'Arche Daybreak Community. In the story of Adam he found a way to describe his own understanding of the Gospel message. Adam could not speak or even move without assistance. Through this story, Nouwen found a new way to tell God's story and the story of all of us human creatures, broken and yet beloved, who live in a world charged and alive with the mystery of God s love. This is a short book (136 pages) that one can order from Amazon (lots of cheap used copies are available) and read quickly before attending the first meeting of the book group. All are most welcome!
