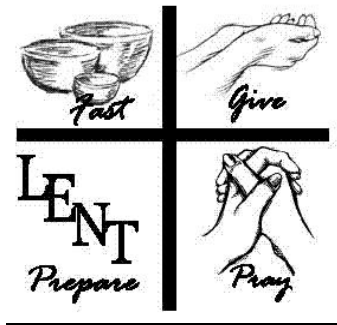

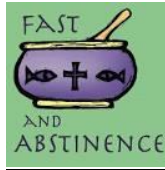

Wednesday night at 7pm**



The Bishops of the United States prescribe, as minimal obligation, that all persons who are 14 years of age and older are bound to abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Friday's of Lent and Good Friday. All persons 18 years of age and older, up to including their 59th birthday, are bound to fast by limiting themselves to a single full meal on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, while the other two meals on those days are to be light. All the faithful are encouraged, when possible, to participate at Mass and to receive Holy Eucharist daily, to frequently attend the Sacrament of Penance, to undertake spiritual reading, especially sacred scripture and to participate in parish Lenten devotions. All are encouraged to participate in Operation Rice Bowl which has aided countless hungry persons here in the Archdiocese as well as throughout our nation and world.
