The Bishops of the United States prescribe, as minimal obligation, that all persons who are 14 years of age and older are bound to abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Friday's of Lent and Good Friday. All persons 18 years of age or older, up to and including their 59th birthday, are bound to fast by limiting themselves to a single meal on Ash Wednesday & Good Friday, with the other 2 meals on those days are to be light. All the faithful are encouraged to participate at Mass and receive Holy Communion daily, undertake spiritual reading, especially sacred scripture and participate in parish Lenten devotions.
