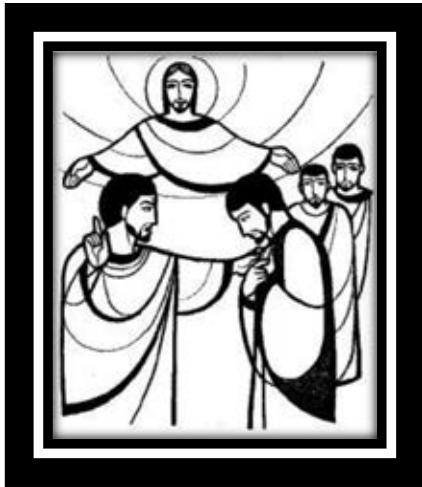

Liturgical Life: Why incense at Liturgies? Common in ancient Jewish worship it crossed over into early Christian Liturgies. In the Psalms it says “Let my prayer be incense before you” and in Revelations “The smoke of the incense along with the prayers of the holy ones went up before God from the hand of an angel.” In Exodus God instructs Moses to build and Altar of Incense as one of only three fixtures in the “holy place” just outside of the Holy of Holies where the Ark of the Covenant was placed. Temple priests would burn incense every morning and evening representing the prayers of the people. In Catholicism it can be used during Mass, in processions, benediction and other liturgical events. At a funeral Mass the deceased is incensed to honor the body which, through Baptism, became a dwelling place of the Holy Spirit. This is a beautiful, sensory way to represent our prayers rising to our God in heaven.

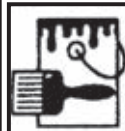
