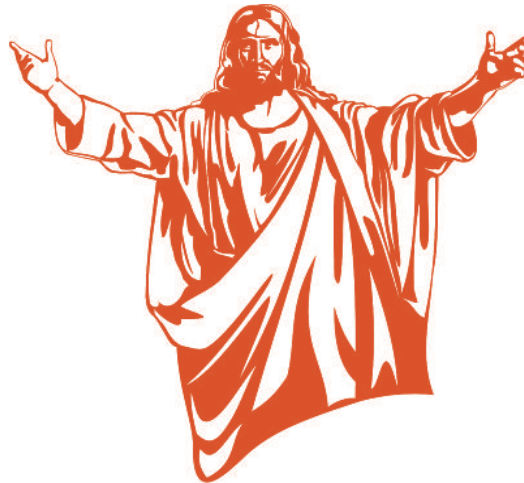

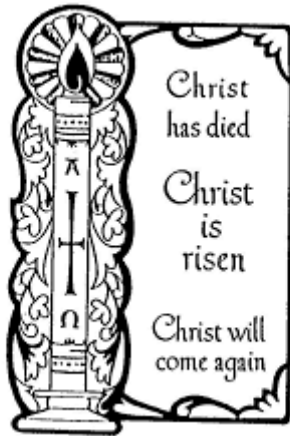

## **Parish Registration**

In order to receive the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, Holy Eucharist or Matrimony or to have access to Letters of Eligibility to stand as a godparent at Baptism or sponsor at Confirmation you need to be registered with a parish. ### The Acts of the Apostles

The "Acts" are attributed to St. Luke because of its similar literary style and because its content picks up where Luke's Gospel ends. Scholars say it was probably written in Rome around 80AD. The Acts are read primarily between Easter and Pentecost as the second reading of the liturgy. Acts often mentions the work of St. Peter and St. Paul (Paul & Luke were close friends), in their role as leaders in the Church. It also describes how the early Church gradually emerged from its Jewish roots and established itself as an independent religion. This separation was primarily due to the fear of the Jewish people that Christianity threatened their cultural heritage and therefore they were suspicious. Chronologically the text starts with Pentecost Sunday in Jerusalem, we learn of St. Stephen (a deacon) who became the first martyr. The evangelization of the Gentiles is documented and we hear the term Christian for the first time in the city of Antioch. We follow Paul and Barnabas in their extensive arduous missionary journeys spreading the faith to the corners of the known world despite shipwrecks, imprisonment, beatings and threats on their lives. Acts is where we get most of our knowledge of the early decades of the Church and the lives and teachings of the Apostles.

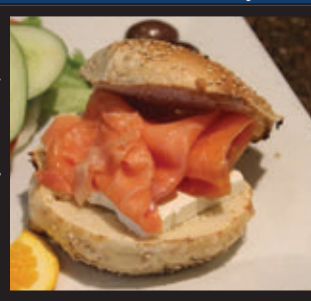
