### Father's Day

Washington State celebrated the first statewide Father's Day on June 19, 1910. Sonora Smart Dodd, one of six children raised by a widower was trying to establish an official equivalent to Mother's Day. She went to local churches, the YMCA, shopkeepers and government officials to support the idea. The idea slowly spread, in 1916 President Wilson honored the day by using telegraph signals to unfurl a flag in Spokane when he pressed a button in Washington, D.C.. In 1924 President Coolidge urged state governments to observe the new holiday. In 1972 President Nixon signed a proclamation making Father's Day a federal holiday. The patron saint of fathers is St. Joseph and often St. Joachim (Blessed Mother's father) is honored as a fatherly role model.

Say a prayer for our dad's and ask that God give them the grace they need to faithfully live out their roles in our families!

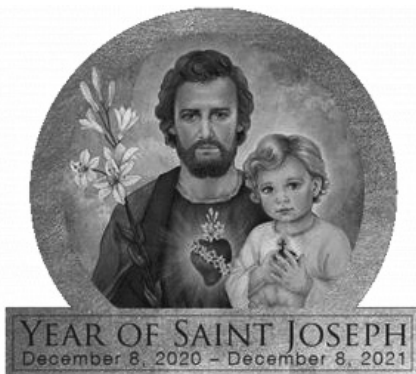

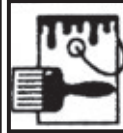
