St. Jude preached the gospel with great passion, often in most difficult circumstances. The Gospels tell us he was the brother of St. James the Less, also one of the Apostles.

He is often confused with Judas Iscariot who betrayed Jesus. He is often depicted carrying the image of Jesus in his hand. This recalls a miracle with King Abagar of Edessa who asked Jesus to cure him of leprosy and sent an artist to bring him a drawing of Jesus. Impressed with his great faith, Jesus pressed His face on a cloth, leaving the image of His face on it. He gave it to Jude who took the image and cured Abagar. He is known as the patron saint of impossible causes. St. Jude's feast day is October 28<sup>th</sup>.

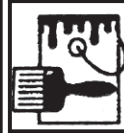
