Christmas is the celebration of God coming into His created world, Emmanuel (God is with us). The word Christmas is a shortened form of "Christ's Mass" or "Cristes Maessa" as it was first recorded in 1038. The Early Church celebrated Easter & Pentecost as the major feasts on the calendar; it was not until the 4<sup>th</sup> century that Christmas and the Epiphany were added to the Liturgical Calendar. The outline of Sacred Scripture can be broken down to just four events; Creation, The Fall, Incarnation and the passion, death & resurrection of Christ. Creation was a world of peace and all things worked according to God's intention. The Fall (Adam & Eve) was man's rejection of God's rule and resulted in physical & spiritual death. Incarnation comes with Christmas, the loving Creator sent His Son into the created world to redeem the Fall by His passion & death. Redemption is not complete until a total restoration of creation to the way it was before the Fall (Christ's second coming). The Old Testament contains over 300 prophecies about the coming Messiah, a savior anointed by God to deliver His people from sin; this of course is what we celebrate at Christmas. Most of these prophecies date thousands of years before the event. It seems like a long wait but in God's good time redemption came into the world. One of the Major Prophets, Isaiah, sums Christmas up; "The glory of the Lord will be revealed, and all flesh will see the salvation of our God."




