Dear St. Philip Neri Families & Friends

We give praise and thanks to God for the graces He has given us. In today's gospel we have the shortest verse of the Bible, "and Jesus wept". Jesus weeps at the tomb of His friend Lazarus. Jesus' weeping expresses the suffering Jesus is experiencing at the death of His friend, and the sorrow that Martha and Mary are experiencing. Jesus does not hold back His feelings - Wow! Anointing of the Sick

Primarily intended as prayers for healing from serious illness
or as a spiritual preparation before surgery, it can involve
multiple sacraments; Penance, Anointing & Eucharist. When
death is imminent, it serves as "Last Rites" which include a
special Apostolic Pardon. Please do not delay in calling for
your elderly or chronically ill family member.
Call the Church Office to schedule an anointing.



Sacrament of Baptism

Baptisms are scheduled for the 2nd & 4th Sunday of every
month immediately following the 11:30AM Mass. For first
time parents, Pre-Jordan classes are required. Deacon Mike
Cipressi conducts these classes via zoom appointments, they
are offered on the 2nd Monday of the month. Godparents are
required to obtain Letters of Eligibility; these letters are due at
the Parish Office at least one week before the scheduled
baptismal date. Call the Church Office at 610-834-1975 to
schedule a Baptism and/or to register for the
Pre-Jordan Class.



Sacrament of Marriage

Arrangements must be made with a priest at least 6 months
prior to your desired wedding date. A Pre-
Cana Class is required and held here at St. Philip's twice per
year, usually in the spring and again in the
fall. Please call the Church Office at 610-834-1975 to schedule
a meeting with a priest and to obtain information on the Pre-
Cana Class. Liturgy and musical planning are done through
Mrs. Jean Martin our Director of Music (215-704-0508).

Convent Update

The Sisters of St. Joseph have been an integral part of the St. Philip Neri family for more than 70 years! Many of our parishioners have been taught by the sisters here at SPN or in other venues across the dioceses or elsewhere. They have generously shared their treasures and talents in so many different ways. The convent the sisters have occupied here at SPN for 70 years is in need of some renovation and repairs, some of which we have already begun to address. New flooring in the community room and on the stairs, installation of new gutter guards, waterproofing the basement to address leaks and water issues, and painting of the 1st floor. One of the main electric lines to our convent after 70 years needs to be replaced along with main electrical panels and circuit breakers. We hope to begin this work in April. Throughout the years, the parishioners of SPN have been very generous in supporting the various campaigns to ensure the parish's growth and maintenance of its buildings. I also want to thank our Women's Guild and our Knights of Columbus for their generosity and time they have given to our convent and to our Sisters of St. Joseph. St. Joseph, pray for us!

Fast & Abstinence

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting & abstinence for Catholics. Fridays in Lent are days of abstinence. Fasting is obligatory from age 18 until age 59. One full meal is permitted as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. Abstinence from meat is binding on those 14 years old and older. Obviously if health issues require a routine daily diet, you are not under obligation.


