

Dear St. Philip Neri Families & Friends

We give praise and thanks to God for the graces He has given us. This past Thursday, we celebrated the Feast of the Ascension, when Jesus, having completed His mission on earth, returned to His Father in heaven. As we reflect on this event, we are reminded of the central message of our faith; that Jesus Christ is Lord and Savior, and that through His death, resurrection, and ascension, He has opened the way to eternal life. The Ascension is not just a historical event that happened over 2,000 years ago, it's a reminder of the ongoing work of God in our lives and in our world. As Jesus ascended into heaven, He promised to send the Holy Spirit to guide and empower His disciples, and through the Holy Spirit, Jesus continues to be present with us.

As we celebrate the Ascension, we are called to remember our own mission as disciples of Christ. We are called to go out into the world and proclaim the good news of salvation to all people. We are called to live lives of faith, hope, and love, embodying the message of Christ in everything we do. This mission is not one that we can fulfill on our own. Like the disciples, we need the power and guidance of the Holy Spirit to carry out the work that God has entrusted to us, so as we celebrate the Ascension, let us ask God to fill us with His Spirit, to give us the courage and wisdom we need to be effective witnesses to His love and grace.

On May 13th, the archbishop ordained three seminarians to the diaconate. Yesterday, seven seminarians were ordained to the priesthood. As their former Dean of Men, I am honored to have been a part of their formation for the priesthood. I ask you to please pray that they will be faithful, loving and compassionate shepherds to God's people. May our Blessed Mother protect and guide them as they share in the priesthood of her Son. Please pray for more vocations to the priesthood and religious life.

Church Roof Update

Today's second collection is for our roof replacement project. This is the second collection for this cause for those who perhaps were not aware of the first one in April. So far we have raised almost \$60,000.00! Thank you all who contributed! The project is costly, especially in these inflationary times, but as the saying goes, it is what it is! We are getting required permits and approvals from local and archdiocesan authorities. Your past donations to the Capital Replacement Fund has allowed us to set aside monies for extraordianay expenses such as this, however it will not cover the total cost. Hopefully the installation will start in June and last 5-6 weeks. Please be as generous as your budgets allow. In the past you have always come through with great generosity, and relying on that spirit of support, we as a parish family will get our roof replaced.

Anointing of the Sick

Primarily intended as prayers for healing from serious illness or as a spiritual preparation before surgery, it can involve multiple sacraments; Penance, Anointing & Eucharist. When death is imminent, it serves as "Last Rites" which include a special Apostolic Pardon. Please do not delay in calling for your elderly or chronically ill family member.

Call the Church Office to schedule an anointing.



Sacrament of Baptism

Baptisms are scheduled for the 2nd & 4th Sunday of every month immediately following the 11:30AM Mass. For first time parents, Pre-Jordan classes are required. Deacon Mike Cipressi conducts these classes via zoom appointments, they are offered on the 2nd Monday of the month. Godparents are required to obtain Letters of Eligibility; these letters are due at the Parish Office at least one week before the scheduled baptismal date. Call the Church Office at 610-834-1975 to schedule a Baptism and/or to register for the Pre-Jordan Class.



Sacrament of Marriage

Arrangements must be made with a priest at least 6 months prior to your desired wedding date. A Pre-Cana Class is required and held here at St. Philip's twice per year, usually in the spring and again in the fall. Please call the Church Office at 610-834-1975 to schedule a meeting with a priest and to obtain information on the Pre-Cana Class. Spiritual Adoption Program

Development of Your Baby / My heart is Beating!

Your baby is making progress developing all of her external features and internal organs. Her brain is functioning at 40 days. Her mother can hear her heartbeat now on an ultrasonic stethoscope. Baby teeth buds are present at 6 1/2 weeks. The central nervous system is functioning and 40 muscle sets begin their first exercises. From this moment, your spiritually adopted baby grows and refines her body.

But everything she needs to survive after birth is already present by the end of the eighth week. She is now called a "fetus" a Latin word meaning "little one". Ultrasound reveals that this little one can now spring, flip and jump – her first dance steps!

St. Philip Neri

He was a Christian missionary and founder of the Congregation of the Oratory, a community of priests and lay brothers. Born in Florence in 1515, from a very young age he was known for being cheerful and obedient, affectionately called "good little Phil". At 18 he went to live with wealthy family members and experienced a mystical vision which he spoke of as his Christian conversion, it changed his life and he set out for Rome to study for the priesthood. After studying 3 years he gave up on any thought of ordination. He set out to help the forgotten poor people of Rome who were no longer really living as Christians. He spoke to them on street corners and town squares, re-evangelizing and awakening their misplaced faith. He caught peoples attention with his warm personality and incredible sense of humor. At 34 he re-entered the seminary and was ordained in 1551. Philip spent hours listening to people of all ages, he spoke to them of Jesus, the saints and the martyrs. He was beloved by the poor of Rome, he was always accessible, especially in the confessional. He soon earned the title the "Apostle of Rome". He died at age 80 in 1595 and is buried in Rome. In the words of one of his biographers, Philip was "all things to all men...when called upon to be merry, he was so; if there was a demand upon his sympathy, he was equally ready..." His feast Day is May 26th. We are blessed as a parish to have such a patron saint!


