

Dear St. Philip Neri Families & Friends

We give praise and thanks to God for the graces He has given us. In today's readings from the Book of Ezekiel and the Gospel of Matthew, we are reminded of our responsibility as members of the Christian community and the importance of reconciliation within our faith communities. Ezekiel, the prophet, speaks to us about the role of a watchman. In ancient times, a watchman was responsible for alerting the city to impending danger. Similarly, as members of the Church, we are called to be spiritual watchmen for our brothers and sisters in Christ. We have a duty to warn and guide one another when we see someone straying from the path of righteousness. This responsibility is rooted in love and care for our fellow believers. However, this duty is not meant to be self-righteous or judgmental. In Matthew's

Gospel, Jesus provides a clear and compassionate process for addressing conflicts and sins within the community of believers. He instructs us to first go to the person privately, seeking reconciliation. If that does not work, we should involve a few others as witnesses to ensure fairness and accountability. And if the person remains unrepentant, it is the responsibility of the community, led by its spiritual leaders, to address the issue. These passages underscore the significance of community within the Christian faith. We are called to be our brothers' and sisters' keepers, not out of a desire to condemn or shame but out of genuine love and concern for their spiritual well-being. Our goal is always reconciliation and restoration, not punishment. In our modern world, where individualism often prevails, it can be challenging to navigate these principles of fraternal correction and community reconciliation. Still, it is a fundamental aspect of our faith. We must remember that these processes are designed to restore unity and harmony within the Body of Christ. As we reflect on these readings, let us ask ourselves how well we are fulfilling our roles as watchman and women in our faith communities. Are we willing to have those difficult conversations with love and humility? Are we open to reconciliation and forgiveness when we have been wronged? May we seek the guidance of the Holy Spirit to help us live out these teachings in our daily lives, for the greater glory of God and the unity of His Church.

Anointing of the Sick

Primarily intended as prayers for healing from serious illness or as a spiritual preparation before surgery, it can involve multiple sacraments; Penance, Anointing & Eucharist. When death is imminent, it serves as “Last Rites” which include a special Apostolic Pardon. Please do not delay in calling for your elderly or chronically ill family member. Call the Church Office to schedule an anointing.



Sacrament of Baptism

Baptisms are scheduled for the 2nd & 4th Sunday of every month immediately following the 11AM Mass. For first time parents, Pre-Jordan classes are required. Deacon Mike Cipressi conducts these classes via zoom appointments, they are offered on the 2nd Monday of the month. Godparents are required to obtain Letters of Eligibility; these letters are due at the Parish Office at least one week before the scheduled baptismal date. Call the Church Office at 610-834-1975 to schedule a Baptism and/or to register for the Pre-Jordan Class.



Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is for individuals interested in exploring and discerning membership in the Catholic Church. 




