Dear St. Philip Neri Families & Friends

We give praise and thanks to God for the graces He has given us. In the rich tapestry of Catholic spirituality, two sources of inspiration come together to illuminate our faith journey; the life and teachings of St. Teresa of Avila and the prophetic vision of Isaiah 25:6-10. These distinct yet harmonious voices guide us toward a deeper understanding of our relationship with God and the profound banquet of divine love that awaits us. Isaiah 25:6-10 paints a vivid picture of a sumptuous banquet prepared by the Lord Himself – feast of rich foods and choice wines, a place where tears are wiped away, and mourning and disgrace are no more. This vision is a foretaste of God's Kingdom, an invitation extended to all people, a promise of redemption, and a celebration of divine love. As we reflect on these verses, we are reminded of God's universal invitation to salvation, an invitation that transcends barriers and welcomes all who turn to Him. St. Teresa of Jesus, often referred to as St. Teresa of Avila, stands as a shining beacon in the history of the Catholic Church. Her life and teachings continue to inspire and guide countless souls on their journey of faith. As a virgin, mystic, and doctor of the Church, St. Teresa offers us profound lessons in spirituality and a deep, personal relationship with God. She invites us to explore the inner chambers of our hearts – a journey akin to entering the mystical banquet of Isaiah's prophecy. St. Teresa's wisdom teaches us that prayer is not merely a recitation of words but a profound dialogue with the Divine. She encourages us to cultivate silence and contemplation, creating a sacred space within ourselves where God's presence can be encountered. In this inner banquet, we experience the transformative power of divine love, just as Isaiah envisioned a feast that turns sorrow into joy and mourning into dancing. Both Isaiah and St. Teresa remind us that this spiritual banquet is not without its challenges. Isaiah acknowledges the pain and sorrow of life, and St. Teresa experienced her own trials and tribulations on her spiritual journey. Yet, both point to the enduring hope and joy that come from a profound relationship with God. St. Teresa's teachings on prayer and contemplation are particularly relevant in our fast-paced and noisy world. She reminds us of the need to cultivate a quiet and receptive heart, creating a space where God's voice can be heard. In a world filled with distractions, her wisdom calls us to seek silence and solitude as being necessary for a deep communion with God. In the union of these two spiritual treasures, we discover a banquet not only of earthly delights but also of heavenly grace – a feast of divine love. It is an invitation to draw closer to God through prayer, contemplation, and a heart open to His transforming love. As we journey through the inner chambers of our souls, may we find solace in the promise of Isaiah and the guidance of St. Teresa, knowing that our tears will be wiped away, and we will one day partake in the eternal banquet of the Lamb.

Sacrament of Marriage

Arrangements must be made with a priest at least 6 months prior to your desired wedding date, contact the Church Office at 610-834-1975 to schedule. The Archdiocese requires that couples attend a Pre-Cana class before marriage. At this time, we ask you to go to www.archphila.org, under marriage preparations to take class on line. Liturgy and musical planning are done through Mrs. Jean Martin our Director of Music (215-704-0508).



Anointing of the Sick

Primarily intended as prayers for healing from serious illness or as a spiritual preparation before surgery, it can involve multiple sacraments; Penance, Anointing & Eucharist. When death is imminent, it serves as "Last Rites" which include a special Apostolic Pardon. Please do not delay in calling for your elderly or chronically ill family member. Call the Church Office to schedule an anointing.



Sacrament of Baptism

Baptisms are scheduled for the 2nd & 4th Sunday of every month immediately following the 11AM Mass. For first time parents, Pre-Jordan classes are required. Deacon Mike Cipressi conducts these classes via zoom appointments, they are offered on the 2nd Monday of the month. Godparents are required to obtain Letters of Eligibility; these letters are due at the Parish Office at least one week before the scheduled baptismal date. Call the Church Office at 610-834-1975 to schedule a Baptism and/or to register for the Pre-Jordan Class.



Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is for individuals interested in exploring and discerning membership in the Catholic Church. This program is for non-Catholics who may or may not have been baptized in another Christian Church and wish to receive the Sacraments of Penance, Confirmation and Holy Eucharist.
