

Dear St. Philip Neri Families & Friends



We give praise and thanks to God for the graces He has given us. In the Gospel of Matthew this Sunday, we encounter the parable of the ten bridesmaids, five of whom were wise and five foolish. The wise bridesmaids came prepared with enough oil for their lamps and were ready to meet the bridegroom when he arrived. On the other hand, the foolish ones did not bring enough oil, and while they went to buy more, the bridegroom came, and the door was closed to them. This parable emphasizes the importance and vigilance in our Christian journey. The lamps in the story symbolize our faith and good works. Being prepared with enough oil means nurturing our faith through a life of prayer, good deeds, and a relationship with God. We must not become complacent or distracted by the concerns of the world, for we do not know the exact moment when the Lord will come. Instead, we are called to keep our lamps burning, our faith alive, and our hearts vigilant. Now, when we turn to the passage from 1st Thessalonians, we find a message of hope and reassurance. Paul writes to the Thessalonian Christians about the resurrection of the dead and the return of the Lord. He encourages them not to grieve for their departed loved ones as those who have no hope. Instead, he tells them that those who have died in Christ will rise first, and those who are alive will be caught up in the air to meet the Lord. The connection between these two passages lies in the shared theme of preparedness and hope. Just as the wise bridesmaids were ready for the bridegroom's arrival, so too should we be prepared for the second coming of Christ. While the bridesmaids represent our vigilance and readiness in our daily lives, the passage from 1st Thessalonians reminds us of the ultimate hope we have in Christ's return. Our faithfulness and vigilance in daily living are not in vain; they are rooted in the hope of the resurrection and the promise of eternal life. In essence, these passages encourage us to live with a sense of urgency, as if the bridegroom's arrival or the Lord's return will be imminent. At the same time, they offer us the comfort of hope, assuring us that our faithfulness will ultimately lead to the joy of being reunited with Christ and our loved ones in the presence of the Lord. Therefore, as we keep our lamps burning with faith and good works, we do so with the confident hope that our faith will be rewarded when the Lord comes again, just as He has promised.



Primarily intended as prayers for healing from serious illness or as a spiritual preparation before surgery, it can involve multiple sacraments; Penance, Anointing & Eucharist. When death is imminent, it serves as "Last Rites" which include a special Apostolic Pardon. Please do not delay in calling for your elderly or chronically ill family member. Call the Church Office to schedule an anointing.



Sacrament of Baptism

Baptisms are scheduled for the 2nd & 4th Sunday of every month immediately following the 11AM Mass. For first time parents, Pre-Jordan classes are required. Deacon Mike Cipressi conducts these classes via zoom appointments, they are offered on the 2nd Monday of the month. Godparents are required to obtain Letters of Eligibility; these letters are due at the Parish Office at least one week before the scheduled baptismal date. 
