

Dear St. Philip Neri Families & Friends



We give praise and thanks to God for the graces He has given us. Today, we joyfully celebrate the solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord, a momentous occasion when the light of Christ burst forth, not only for a select few but for the entire world. The Gospel of Matthew (2:1-12)

recounts the journey of the Magi, wise men from the East, who followed a star to pay homage to the newborn King of the Jews. In their journey and homage, we find profound lessons that continue to illuminate our own paths. The Magi were guided by a star – a celestial beacon that directed them to the source of true light. In

our lives, God provides us with guidance through various signs and inspirations. The Epiphany challenges us to pay attention to the guiding stars in our own journeys. How attuned are we to the signs God places before us? Are we willing to follow His guiding light? The Magi embarked on a long and uncertain journey, a pilgrimage that required faith and perseverance. Our

Christian journey is similarly a pilgrimage of faith, marked by trust in God's plan and willingness to follow wherever He leads. As we reflect on the Magi's journey, let us ask ourselves; how deep is our trust in God's

providence? Are we willing to persevere in faith, even when faced with challenges and uncertainties? The Magi presented gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh – a gesture of homage and an acknowledgement of Jesus' kingship, divinity, and redemptive sacrifice. The

Epiphany challenges us to offer our own gifts to Christ – our talents, time, and sacrifices. In what ways are we presenting our gifts to the Lord? How can we use our abilities and resources to glorify God and serve others?

Upon reaching the Christ child, the Magi prostrated themselves in worship. Their act of reverence teaches us the importance of true worship and adoration. As we gather for Mass and prayer, are our hearts disposed to worship? Do we approach the Eucharist with awe and humility, recognizing the real presence of Christ in the Blessed Sacrament? The Feast of the Epiphany invites us to reflect on the ways Christ is revealed to us and

through us. Like the Magi, may we be attentive to God's guidance, may our faith sustain us on our journey, may our gifts be laid at the feet of Christ, and may our worship be sincere and humble. As we celebrate this feast, let us pray for the grace to be bearers of the light of Christ, shining brightly in a world that hungers for the truth, love, and salvation found in the newborn King.

May the Epiphany be not only a historical event but a personal encounter that transforms our lives and radiates Christ's light to all whom we encounter.

Please invite someone to Mass. St. Philip Neri, pray for us. Merry Christmas and a blessed New Year to you and your families!

Sacrament of Marriage

The Archdiocese requires that couples attend a Pre-Cana class before marriage. At this time, we ask you to go to www.archphila.org, under marriage preparations to take class on line. Liturgy and musical planning are done through Mrs. Jean Martin our Director of Music (215-704-0508).



Anointing of the Sick

Primarily intended as prayers for healing from serious illness or as a spiritual preparation before surgery, it can involve multiple sacraments; Penance, Anointing & Eucharist. When death is imminent, it serves as "Last Rites" which include a special Apostolic Pardon. Please do not delay in calling for your elderly or chronically ill family member. Call the Church Office to schedule an anointing.



Sacrament of Baptism

Baptisms are scheduled for the 2nd & 4th Sunday of every month immediately following the 11AM Mass. For first time parents, Pre-Jordan classes are required. Deacon Mike Cipressi conducts these classes via zoom appointments, they are offered on the 2nd Monday of the month. Godparents are required to obtain Letters of Eligibility; these letters are due at the Parish Office at least one week before the scheduled baptismal date. 


