


#### We Pray

Dear St. Philip Neri Friends and Family,

We give praise and thanks to God for the graces and blessings He has given us. Today's Gospel presents one of the most well-known and beloved parables in all of Scripture; the Parable of the Good Samaritan. We have heard it so many times that we might think we have mastered the message. Help those in need.

Do not pass by. Be kind. That is all true. But Jesus always invites us deeper. His parables are not just stories with morals. They are mirrors that reflect who we are, and doors that show us who we are called to become. The Gospel begins with a question from a scholar of the law; "What must I do to inherit eternal life?" Jesus turns the question back to him, and the man answers with the Shema, the great commandment from Deuteronomy; love God with all your heart, soul, strength, and mind; and love your neighbor as yourself. So far, so good. But when the scholar, "wanting to justify himself", asks, "and who is my neighbor?". That's when Jesus tells the parable. Notice how the question shifts. The scholar wants a clear category. He wants a checklist. Who counts as a neighbor? Who doesn't? Jesus doesn't give him a list. Instead tells a story that destroys the question entirely! In the story, a man is beaten, robbed, and left half-dead. A priest passes by. Then a Levite. Both religious men. Both presumably upstanding. Both pass by. They may have had good reasons. The road was dangerous. Touching a half-dead body could have rendered them unclean. Their religious duties may have seemed to come first. But here comes a Samaritan. A man despised by Jews. Considered a heretic. An outsider. And it is this Samaritan who stops. Who sees. Who has compassion. Who binds the man's wounds, lifts him onto his animal, takes him to safety, and pays for his care. Jesus flips the expected roles. The neighbor is not identified by blood, by race, by religion, or by status. The neighbor is the one who shows mercy. At the end, Jesus does not ask, "Which person was a neighbor to the Samaritan?" Instead, He asks, "Which of these was *neighbor* to the man in need?" in other words, the better question is not "Who is my neighbor?" but rather "How can *I* be a neighbor?" That is a question of the heart. And what does it mean to be a neighbor? It means to see suffering and not look away. It means to let compassion interrupt your schedule, your comfort, and even your security. It means to act, not just feel. In our own lives, we pass by many people lying "half-dead" on the road. Some are physically suffering. Others emotional broken. Some are strangers. Others live under our own roof. But we must also remember. Jesus is not just giving us a moral challenge. Jesus is revealing His own heart. Jesus Himself is the true Good Samaritan. He saw us beaten and broken by sin. He didn't pass us by. He came to us. He entered our world, bound our wounds, lifted us up, and paid for our healing with His very life. And now Jesus says to us, "Go and do likewise." Not because we are trying to earn heaven, but because we have been loved so deeply that we cannot help but love in return. So today, let us not ask, "who is my neighbor?" Let us ask, "Lord, how can I be a neighbor like You?" May our eyes be open to those in need. May our hearts be moved by compassion. May our lives reflect the mercy of the One who first had mercy on us.
