Dear St. Philip Neri Friends and Family,

We give praise and thanks to God for the graces and blessings He has given us. As the month of July draws to a close, we are reminded that this is the month the Church dedicates to the Most Precious Blood of Jesus.

It is time to reflect on the mystery of Christ's sacrificial love; love poured out fully and freely for our salvation. The Blood of Christ is not only a symbol of His suffering, it is the price of our redemption, the proof of God's unshakable love for each one of us. Today's Gospel, then, arrives at just the right moment. We hear Jesus teaching His disciples how to pray. They ask Him, "Lord, teach us to pray", and He responds by giving them, and us, the Lord's Prayer. These words are familiar, perhaps even too familiar. We recite them so often that we may forget how radical they are. Jesus teaches us to call God "Father". This is not the distant, unapproachable deity of ancient religions. This is a Father who is near, who loves, who provides, and who listens. When we say "Father", we step into a relationship rooted in trust, not fear. And we are reminded that we are His beloved children, not just individually, but together. We pray "our Father", not "my Father", because we are part of a family. The rest of the prayer places us in a posture of humility. We ask for God's kingdom, not our own. We ask for daily bread; not an excess, not a stockpile, but what we need today. We ask for forgiveness, but only as we extend it to others. And we ask for strength in trials, knowing that we cannot stand alone. Jesus then continues with a parable that shows the power of persistence in prayer. A man knocks on his friend's door at midnight asking for bread. At first, the friend resists. But because of the man's persistence, he gets what he needs. Jesus is not saying that God is reluctant like the neighbor. He is telling us that persistence can move an unwilling friend, how much more will our loving

Father respond to those who trust Him and seek Him with open hearts? Jesus says, "Ask and you will receive, seek and you will find, knock and the door will be opened to you." These are not empty promises.

They are invitations. Our Father delights in our prayers. He may not always answer them in the way we expect, but He always gives us what we truly need; above all, the gift of Himself. In fact, Jesus says the Father will give the Holy Spirit to those who ask. That is the greatest gift. Not comfort, not success, not even health, but the very presence of God in our lives. A Father who gives His Spirit is a Father who gives us everything. And this brings us back to the Precious Blood. Because everything we have, the privilege to call

God "Father", the ability to be forgiven, the gift of the Holy Spirit, it all comes through the sacrifice of

Christ. We can knock boldly because Jesus first knocked down the barrier of sin. We can ask with confidence because He first gave everything, even His blood, for us. So, as we finish this month dedicated to the Precious Blood, let us remember that prayer is not just about words or requests. It is about relationship. It

is about standing before the Father with the confidence of beloved children redeemed by the Son. Let us pray with trust. Let us seek with hope. Let us knock with faith. And let our hearts never forget the price that made such prayer possible; the Precious Blood of Jesus, poured out in love.

Please invite someone to Mass today. St. Philip Neri, pray for us!

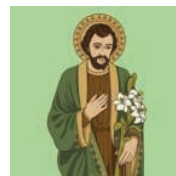
