Dear St. Philip Neri Friends and Family,

We give praise and thanks to God for the graces and blessings He has given us! The Gospel presents us with a lesson on humility that comes directly from the lips of Jesus. As He observes the guests choosing the places of honor at a meal, He offers a parable that goes much deeper than table etiquette. What Jesus teaches is not simply a matter of social politeness, but a truth about how we are called to live before God and others.

“Everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, but the one who humbles himself will be exalted.” These words are both a warning and a promise. Jesus is calling us to embrace the virtue of humility, not only in how we relate to others, but in how we see ourselves before God. In the world, we are often encouraged to promote ourselves, to seek recognition, to climb the ladder of success. But Jesus tells us to take the lowest place. Why? Because humility puts us in right relationship with God and others. It reminds us that all we have is a gift from God. Our talents, our achievements, our very lives are not things we have earned, but blessings we have received. Humility is not about thinking less of ourselves. Looking at our talents and limitations and accepting them. It is also, about thinking of ourselves less. It is about recognizing that others are just as valuable and beloved by God as we are. When we put others first, when we do not demand attention or seek status, we begin to live as Christ lived. Jesus did not cling to His divine glory. He emptied Himself. He took the lowest place. He was born in a manger, lived in poverty, died on a cross and even His tomb was a gift from another. Because of Jesus’ humility, the Father highly exalted Him. He is our model. Jesus invites us to follow Him, not by climbing up, but by kneeling down. The second part of today’s Gospel is just as important. Jesus tells the host, “When you hold a banquet, invite the poor, the crippled, the lame, the blind.” In other words, serve those who cannot repay you. Love those who are overlooked. Welcome those who are on the margins. This teaching is especially relevant as we end the month of August and look ahead to September, which often brings a new school year, a return to routines, a refocusing of our priorities. It is a good time to ask: How are we living the virtue of humility? Do we seek recognition for what we do, or are we content to serve quietly? Do we make space for others, especially those who are often left out? The altar of the Lord, the Eucharist, is the great banquet to which we are all invited, not because of our status or achievements, but because of God’s mercy. None of us can repay Him, yet God invites us, feeds us, and gives us life. So, let us come to this altar with humble hearts, grateful for the place God has given us. Then let us go forth ready to take the lowest place, to serve with joy, and to follow Christ who humbled Himself for our sake. May the Blessed Virgin Mary, whose heart is humble and pure, pray for us and help us to walk the path of true humility that leads to glory in the kingdom of God.
