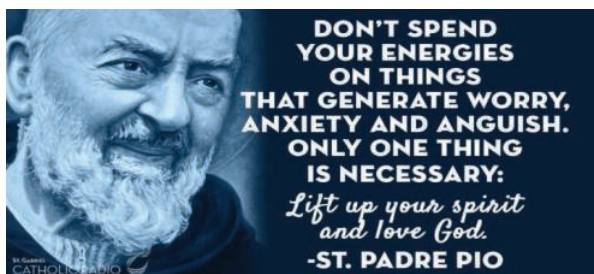

Dear St. Philip Neri Friends and Family,

We give praise and thanks to God for the graces and blessings He has given us! The Gospel this Sunday (Luke 16:1-13) presents us with one of the most puzzling parables. Jesus tells us the story of the dishonest steward. At first glance, it can sound as if Jesus is praising dishonesty, but that is not His message. Instead, Jesus is holding up the steward as an example of shrewdness and foresight. The steward knew he was about to lose his job, and he acted quickly to prepare for his future. Jesus uses this parable to teach us about urgency and wisdom in our spiritual lives. If we put as much energy, creativity, and dedication into preparing for eternal life as the steward did for his earthly security, what a difference it would make. The steward acted decisively because he knew his time was short. Brothers and sisters, our time is also short. Life passes quickly, and Jesus calls us to use it well; not in dishonest ways, but in ways that reflect justice, mercy, and love. Jesus also says, "You cannot serve both God and mammon." In other words, we cannot let money, possessions, or worldly success become the master of our hearts. These things can be useful, but they are not ultimate. God alone is our master. And if our hearts are divided, if we try to serve both God and worldly gain, we will inevitably drift away from God. The readings today ask us to examine how we use what has been entrusted to us. Amos, in the first reading, condemned those who used their wealth and power to exploit the poor. He reminds us that God's justice is not blind to the cries of those who are oppressed. The Psalm adds; "Praise the Lord who lifts up the poor." God's heart is always with the weak, the forgotten, the ones who have nothing. So how are we using the gifts God has given us? Are we using our treasurers, our time, our talents in a way to assist with God's kingdom? Or are we tempted to keep them only for ourselves? The Lord is not asking us to despise wealth or possessions, but He is asking us to hold them lightly and use them generously. Think of the saints. They understood that everything they had was meant to be used for God's glory and for service to others. St. Lawrence, one of the deacons of Rome, was once ordered by the authorities to bring the treasurers of the Church. He gathered the poor, the sick, and the orphans, and presented them as the true treasurers. That is the kind of vision Jesus wants us to have; to see people, especially the most venerable, as the real riches of God's kingdom. In our daily lives, this might look like using our gifts to help a family in need, to visit the sick, or to give our time to those who are lonely. Even the smallest acts, when done with love, are treasures stored up in heaven. Brothers and sisters, the dishonest steward was praised because he acted decisively in the face of urgency. Jesus is asking us to act decisively too. Not in dishonesty, but in faith. Not in selfishness, but in generosity. Let us not wait until tomorrow to live as faithful disciples. Let us decide today that God alone is our Lord and Master, and let us use every gift He has given us for His glory and for the good of others. May we live with the wisdom to see what truly matters. May we serve the Lord with undivided hearts, and may we one day hear the words we long for most; "Well done, good and faithful servant. Enter into the joy of your Master."
