Dear St. Philip Neri Friends and Family,

We give praise and thanks to God for the graces and blessings He has given us! The Gospel this Sunday tells the story of ten lepers who cry out to Jesus for healing. All ten are cleansed, but only one, a Samaritan, returns to give thanks and praise to God. Jesus asks, "Were not all ten cleansed? Where are the other nine?" This story is about gratitude, but it is also about faith. The one who returned to thank Jesus not only received physical healing, but also heard the words, "Your faith has saved you." It is easy to ask God's help when we are in need. We bring

Him our struggles, our sicknesses, our worries and our fears. But how often do we remember to return with gratitude? I know how easy it is for me to forget to thank God. Gratitude deepens our relationship with God. It reminds us that every good gift comes from Him. It transforms our prayers from requests into songs of praise. The Samaritan shows us that true faith is not only about receiving blessings, but about recognizing the Giver and offering thanks. In the first reading from Second Kings, Naaman the Syrian is healed of leprosy by following the prophet Elisha's instructions. Like the Samaritan in the Gospel, Naaman returns to give thanks, proclaiming that there is no God except the God of Israel. Gratitude leads him to faith, and faith leads him to worship. The message is clear; when we see God's work in our lives, we must not remain silent. We must respond with thanksgiving and praise. This theme of faith and gratitude ties beautifully into the Church's devotion this month.

October is dedicated to Our Lady of the Rosary, and on October 13th, we honor Our Lady of Fatima, who appeared to three shepherd children in Portugal in 1917. Mary's message at Fatima was simple but profound; pray, especially the Rosary, do penance, and turn back to God. Her call was not just for the children, but for the whole world. She reminded us that prayer has power, that conversion is possible, and that gratitude for God's mercy should move us to live holier lives. At Fatima, Mary showed her concern for the world in turmoil, urging prayer for peace and for sinners. She asked for reparation, not because God needs our prayers, but because our prayers change us. They open our hearts, they deepen our faith, and they show our gratitude for all God has done. The children of Fatima, though young and poor, responded with great generosity. Their "yes" to Mary's message reminds us that holiness and gratitude are not reserved for the powerful or the wealthy. They are for anyone who opens the heart to God. Just as only one leper returned to thank Jesus, so often only a few respond fully to God's invitations. Our Lady of Fatima challenges us not to be among the nine who forget, but to be like the one who returns with thanksgiving. She calls us to be faithful, to pray the Rosary, to do penance, and to live with grateful hearts. Brothers and sisters, this week let us ask ourselves; Do we return to thank God for the blessings in our lives, or do we take them for granted? Do we live as people of gratitude, showing our faith by our words and our actions? And do we listen to Mary's call at Fatima to pray for peace, to turn away from sin, and to trust in the mercy of God? May we, like the Samaritan leper, return to Jesus with hearts full of thanksgiving. May Our Lady of Fatima intercede for us, that our faith may grow strong, our prayer may be constant, and our gratitude may draw us ever closer to Christ. Pope Leo has asked us to pray a Rosary every day during the month of October for peace.

Please invite someone to Mass today. St. Philip Neri, pray for us! Have a blessed day,

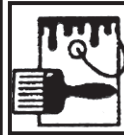
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
