Dear St. Philip Neri Friends and Family,

We give praise and thanks to God for the graces and blessings He has given us! Today the Church celebrates All Souls Day, we gather with hearts that remember. We remember those who have fallen asleep in the arms of Jesus. We pray for those who are being purified, the Holy Souls in purgatory who await the fulness of God's presence. We place our hope in the promise proclaimed by today's readings; that God is faithful, that God is merciful, and that God desires eternal life for all His children. In our first reading from the Book of Wisdom, we hear those consoling words; "The souls of the just are in the hand of God." Even when death appears to be a defeat, God is holding their lives secure. There is no terror, no loss, no suffering that can separate us or our loved ones from God's love. What appears broken in our eyes is being healed in His. The responsorial psalm assures us that the Lord is our shepherd, guiding us through every valley, even the valley of death, and leading us toward green pastures and restful waters. Death is not the end of the journey but a passage into God's eternal peace. In the Gospel of John, Jesus speaks directly to our grief; "This is the will of my Father, that everyone who sees the Son and believes in Him may have eternal life, and shall raise them on the last day." Today is not only a day of sorrow. It is day of promise. For many of us, this month carries deep emotion. For me, this is the first Holy Souls month without my father. Grief is a sign of love, and when someone we love dies, the world does not feel the same. There is a new emptiness, a new silence, and a new ache. Like many of you grieving a loved one – I would do anything or offer anything to talk and spend time with my dad just one more time. Yet there is also a new hope, because our faith tells us that our lives and love does not end at death. The bonds we formed in Christ are not broken. We pray for our loved ones and we trust that Jesus, the Good Shepherd, is bringing them into the fullness of His Heavenly Kingdom where they will forever be in His love. Please take some comfort in knowing that all of our loved ones and friends who have gone before us are present worshiping God at every Mass. Look at the altar, then close your eyes and see them there smiling at us. Then I like to move a little bit in a pew to make room for them to sit next to us. God desires for us to know He has taken care of our loved ones and they are still with us – praying for us and loving us. Talk to them for they are still talking to us. During this month of the Holy Souls, we honor God's mercy by praying for the deceased. We offer Masses for them, we visit their resting places, and we commend them to God's care. Our prayers are a gift of love. They help carry our family members and friends toward the everlasting joy that God desires for them in His kingdom. This month also leads us toward another season of hope. On November 30th, we will begin the season of Advent. The year will turn once again toward expectation, as we prepare our hearts for the coming of Christ. In this way, November is both a month of solemn remembrance and a month of renewed hope. We remember those who have died, and we look forward to the promise of life that continues in Christ. We ask Jesus to stay with us. We invite Jesus into our grief and into our hope. We trust that He sees each soul clearly, both here and in the life to come. We give thanks that salvation has come into our homes, to our families, and to our world through Him. May Jesus, the Good Shepherd, comfort those who mourn. May the Holy Spirit be embraced by God's love and brought quickly into His glory. May we live each day with a faith that looks forward to the day when we will be reunited with those we love, in the presence of Christ, who conquered death forever.

Eternal rest grant to them O, Lord. And let perpetual light shine upon them. May they rest in peace. Amen.

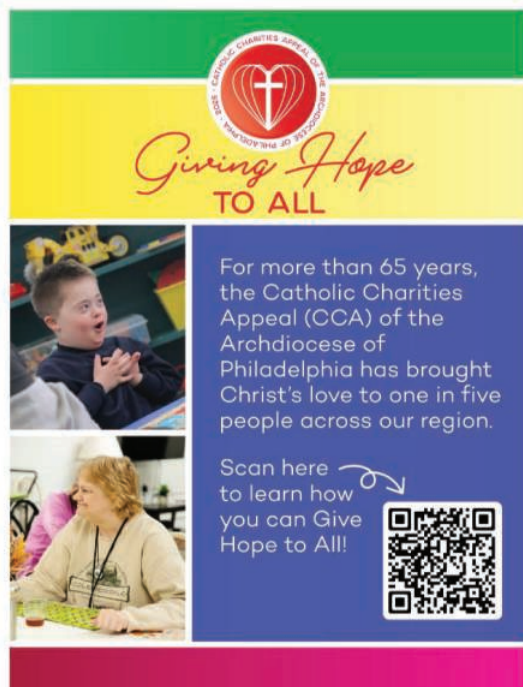

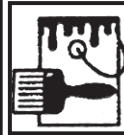
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
