<u>PARISH RELIGIOUS</u> <u>EDUCATION PROGRAM</u>

REGISTRATION for the Parish Religious Education Program (CCD) is now being finalized for 2011-2012. Books and materials need to be ordered. The day of choice will be limited to the number of children who can ride the bus meeting a safe and legal limit.
