PARISH RELIGIOUS EDUCATION PROGRAM

REGISTRATION for the **Parish Religious Education Program (CCD)** is now being taken for 2013-2014. Those registered at Saint Philip's with an incoming child in Kindergarten and Grade 1 already received a letter and registration form. Those currently enrolled have already received their materials. The cost of the program is \$175 for one child and \$225 for 2 or more children. If you only have one or more children in Kindergarten, the cost is \$100. Kindergarten classes are on Sunday mornings from 10:00-10:50 AM. Grades 1-6 have classes on Monday

and Tuesday afternoons from 4:00-5:30 PM. Bus transportation is available from Whitemarsh Elementary, Ridge Park, and Colonial Elementary both days for \$50 per family. A child needs to attend only one class per week. The day of choice will be limited to the number of children who can ride the bus meeting a safe and legal limit. If you like children, have faith in God, and would like to get involved at Saint Philip's we will supply you with catechetical training, teaching manuals, and resources. Articles of Faith: Our last Year of Faith meeting will be Sunday, August 4th, at 7PM in the School Library. We will be studying the 10th, 11th, and 12th Articles of Faith in the Creed, "I confess one Baptism for the forgiveness of sins and I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come." We will study this by viewing and discussing Lesson 10 of the DVD Series *Catholicism*, by Father Robert Barron, "World without end – the last things." One thing that we will learn is that the God establishes the precedent for the Pope, his "Prime Minister" in the Old Testament. Jesus Christ gave the Apostles, represented by Peter, the power to forgive Sins. This commission is justified in the readings of both the Old and New Testaments.
