Liturgical Life: What is the Communion of Saints? In Catholic terminology "saints" refer to those who have been perfected and are now in God's presence (heaven) sharing in His divine Nature. Some are recognized by name because of the outstanding life they led and many, many others who go nameless but none-the-less equally share in God's glory. The Communion of Saints encompasses those of us still on earth, those who have passed but still journeying to God (purgatory) and those who abide with God in heaven. These stages are sometimes referred to as the Church militant (earthly), suffering (purgatory) and triumphant (heaven). So in this communion we are all connected as the Body of Christ and in His conquering of death share in His Resurrection. We are to pray for each other no matter what "stage" we are in, brothers and sisters all and always!




