**Liturgical Life:** The vestments worn by the priest are of Greco-Roman origins, the dress of the common man in the early days of the Church. The vestments worn by the Old Testament Jewish Priests followed a strict design as outlined in Exodus, this design did not make the jump to Christianity. As time went on the quality of the material and designs became more elaborate. They satisfy a twofold purpose; so the people can recognize the priest and his office and so the priest himself is made more aware of his position by virtue of his ordination. Vestments are *sacramentals*, that is, they are sacred signs or symbols to help point or focus people to think more about the true reality of the sacraments. The basic vestments are the alb (baptism), cincture (self-mastery), stole (priesthood), and chasuble (charity). The colors change depending on the season or liturgy/feast day being celebrated. Green signifies anticipation & hope, purple-penance & preparation, white-resurrection, and red-blood and the Holy Spirit. The Church uses imagery and color to draw the faithful's attention to Sacred Mysteries.




