**Liturgical Life:** During our Forty Hours Eucharistic Devotion last week, Fr. Anthony spoke about boats and their role as symbols in Scripture. Boats are one of the oldest Christian symbols dating back to the Catacombs! Ancient peoples saw the sea as unpredictable and chaotic and even believed it to be a part of creation that God had not yet "tamed". So the boat represented safety while crossing the untamed chaos and spiritually represents the Church protecting us from the chaos of sin and life outside of Christ. St. Peter being the first pope was a fisherman so the connection of boat as Church was easily made with Peter as the helmsman. The Church was often compared to Noah's Ark, carrying not animals but souls through this world of disbelief and worldliness and delivering them to the safe harbor of heaven. Many saints are depicted in paintings holding a boat (the Church), with a mast and yardarm forming a cross to emphasize the role of the Church on earth. The central seating area of a church is called the "nave" a Latin word for "ship", so through the Church we are seeking protection from the turmoil of this world and moving toward heaven with the Church as our vehicle.

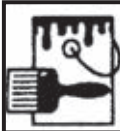
