Liturgical Life: Twenty-three Catholic Churches? Roman Catholics are not the only Catholics; there are seven "rites" that make up the Holy Catholic Church. They are the Latin Rite, Alexandrian Rite, Syrian Rite, Armenian Rite, Chaldean Rite, Maronite Rite and the Byzantine Rite. To make things even more complicated within those six rites there are twenty-four churches! To be clear from the start we are all part of the Catholic Church, all of the churches are in communion with each other and Universal Catholic Church and all recognize the primacy of the Pope. At large Vatican Liturgies the unique vestments can be seen as they reflect the culture and traditions of the geographical location of the particular rite. These rites developed as a result of 1st century evangelization. The early Church sought to evangelize the major cultural centers of the time; Rome, Antioch and Alexandria being the main centers. The various rites evolved from the liturgical practices and ecclesiastical organization adopted in those areas. We are the Latin or Roman Rite as well as the only western rite and also the largest by far. The others are all eastern churches and their customs and traditions are reflective of their local area. Together we are one worldwide community of believers and followers of Jesus Christ in the one, true Church He founded.




