

Changes at Mass

You may have noticed a slight change in the Liturgy. The lector still processes in with the presider, deacons and altar servers, but now takes a seat in the assembly, instead of a chair by the ambo. These changes are directed by the Archdiocese, guided by the General Instruction of the Roman Missal pertinent to all Catholic worship, and are important to maintain "consistent practice" of the liturgy, so that all will feel at home no matter what parish you might attend. There are benefits to these changes, some very practical. The area near the ambo can be "high traffic" with a variety of people coming and going, so the change streamlines such movement. It is also more family friendly, in that couples and families are not separated for the entire Mass. The other reasons are more spiritual, first, it emphasizes that the lector is called out of the assembly to service, in the same way as Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist, the ushers and those who serve the music ministry as choir members are. Consider it a subtle reminder that we are all called to service of various kinds. Secondly, it is being done to honor a period of silence in between the readings and the responsorial psalm. In our ever quickening, media-overload lifestyle, the beauty and importance of silence is often missing from the celebration of the Liturgy of the Word. It is the hope that you will use the silence to reflect, to identify what really strikes you from the readings, and to decide how to respond to the perspectives offered in the Word of God.
