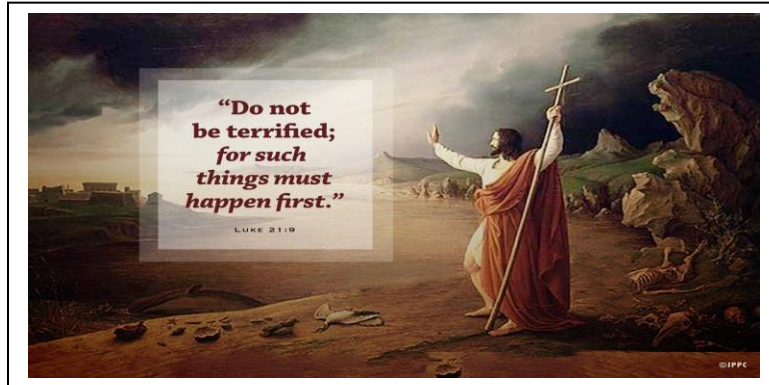

Thoughts from Fr. Szparagowski

We give praise and thanks to God for the graces He has given us. On Nov 4th, we celebrated the feast day of St. Martin de Porres was born in Lima, Peru on Dec 9, 1579.

St. Martin was the illegitimate son to a Spanish gentleman and a freed slave from Panama, of African or possibly Native American descent. At a young age, St. Martin's father abandoned him, his mother and his younger sister. Leaving St. Martin to grow up in deep poverty. After spending just two years in primary school, St. Martin was placed with a barber/surgeon where he would learn to cut hair and the medical arts. St. Martin took vows as a third order Dominican. He spent his time taking care of the poor, sick and slaves. He was often known to go to the docks and take care of the African slaves as they came off the Spanish trade ships. He showed them God's love and compassion. He treated everyone as a beloved son and daughter of God regardless of their wealth, race or status. St. Martin had a compassionate heart to love everyone. St. Martin teaches us not to judge people by their wealth, status or race. Many of his fellow religious took St. Martin as their spiritual director, he continued to call himself a "poor slave".

May St. Martin de Porres pray for us, so our hearts are always open to respond with compassion and charity to all those in need.

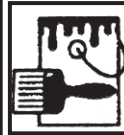
