The covid pandemic drastically affected Mass attendance. At our Archdiocesan workshop in October, Archbishop Perez informed us the percentage of Catholics attending Sunday Mass in the Archdiocese is between 10 to 12%. I know how much we want to change this trend and see our brothers and sisters attend Mass with us. We need to encourage our Catholic friends and family members to please come back to Mass and receive Jesus in the most Blessed Sacrament. I do realize having this conversation at times with people is not easy.

## Thoughts from Fr. Szparagowski

"Beloved, now is the acceptable time spoken of by the Spirit, the day of salvation, peace and reconciliation; the great season of Advent. This is the time eagerly awaited by the patriarchs and prophets, the time that holy Simeon rejoiced to see. This is the season that the Church has always celebrated with special solemnity. We too should always observe it with faith and love, offering praise and thanksgiving to the Father for the mercy and love He has shown us in this mystery."

Many people know the popular symbols & customs of Advent, such as the Advent Wreath, but do not know their meanings and why we have them? Below is a list of some well-known Advent symbols and the meanings behind them.

The Advent Wreath is one of the best-known symbols of Advent.

- Traditionally made of evergreen branches formed into a circle with 4 candles.
- The circle is a symbol of eternal life, green from the evergreen is for hope.
- It started as a domestic tradition that entered into Churches in the 20<sup>th</sup> century.
- The candles are usually 3 purple and 1 pink.
- The candles recall the weeks that pass until Christmas.
- Purple symbolizes waiting and is penitential (not the same way as Lent).
- Pink is used on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of Advent symbolizing rejoicing; this is also referred to as Gaudete (rejoice) Sunday.
- They are lit as a symbol of Christ, the Light of the world, coming through the darkness.
- Sometimes a white candle is placed in the middle of the wreath representing Christ coming into the world.

The Jesse Tree is named for Jesse the father of King David whose line can be traced to St. Joseph, the earthly father of Jesus.

- It is used as a symbol to explain the Old Testament generational connection between Adam, Abraham and Jesus as explained in the Gospels.
- An Advent House or Advent calendar show the passing of the days of the season.
- Popular with children, they serve as a way to provide activities and reflections on the season to draw them deeper into the Faith.
- A visual tool of preparation and patiently waiting for Christ to come into our lives.
