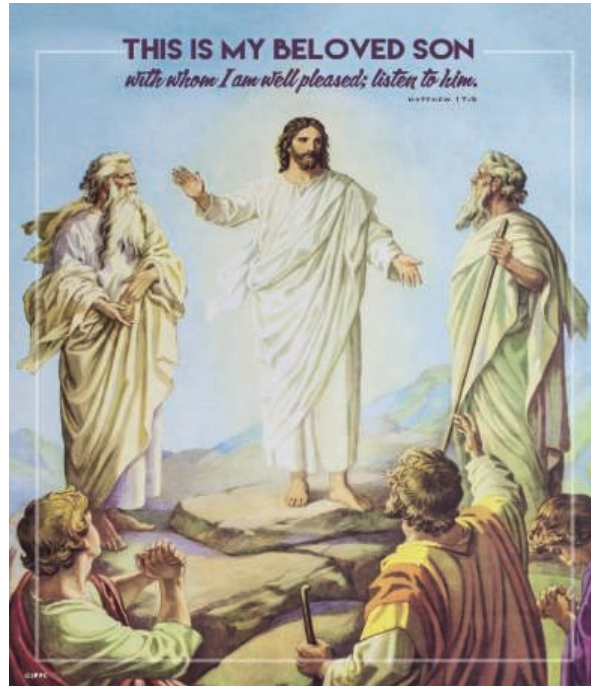

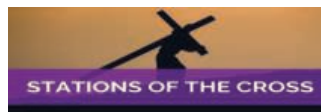

In order to receive the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, Holy Eucharist or Matrimony or to have access to Letters of Eligibility to stand as a godparent at Baptism or sponsor at Confirmation you need to be registered with a parish. Young adults who turn 26 or complete higher education and continue to reside within our area should register individually.

Dear St. Philip Neri Families & Friends

We give praise and thanks to God for the graces He has given us. In today's Gospel, we encounter the Transfiguration of Jesus on Mount Tabor. Have you ever thought...Was Peter wrong to want to build altars for Jesus, Moses, and Elijah? No. As a faithful Jew, Peter was taught his whole life about the importance of Moses and Elijah to the Jewish Faith. In Jewish history, altars were built where there was an encounter with God. Now Jesus changed everything in a new way; for in Jesus, we have the fulfillment of the Old Covenants, God, the Father, in a loving way, speaks to Peter and instructs him to listen to Jesus, His beloved Son.

During Lent it is easy to focus on what we are giving up for Lent or devotions we are praying, instead of listening and staying close to Jesus. If this does happen, we need to take a moment to close our eyes and allow Our Heavenly Father to assist us to listen to Jesus as He did with Peter.

Anointing of the Sick

Primarily intended as prayers for healing from serious illness or as a spiritual preparation before surgery, it can involve multiple sacraments; Penance, Anointing & Eucharist. When death is imminent, it serves as "Last Rites" which include a special Apostolic Pardon. Please do not delay in calling for your elderly or chronically ill family member. Call the Church Office to schedule an anointing.



Sacrament of Baptism

Baptisms are scheduled for the 2nd & 4th Sunday of every month immediately following the 11:30AM Mass. For first time parents, Pre-Jordan classes are required. Deacon Mike Cipressi conducts these classes via zoom appointments, they are offered on the 2nd Monday of the month. Godparents are required to obtain Letters of Eligibility; these letters are due at the Parish Office at least one week before the scheduled baptismal date. Call the Church Office at 610-834-1975 to schedule a Baptism and/or to register for the Pre-Jordan Class.



Sacrament of Marriage

Arrangements must be made with a priest at least 6 months prior to your desired wedding date. A Pre-Cana Class is required and held here at St. Philip's twice per year, usually in the spring and again in the fall. Please call the Church Office at 610-834-1975 to schedule a meeting with a priest and to obtain information on the Pre-Cana Class. Liturgy and musical planning is done through Mrs. Jean Martin our Director of Music (215-704-0508).

Fast & Abstinence

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting & abstinence for Catholics. Fridays in Lent are days of abstinence. Fasting is obligatory from age 18 until age 59. One full meal is permitted as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. Abstinence from meat is binding on those 14 years old and older. Obviously if health issues require a routine daily diet, you are not under obligation.

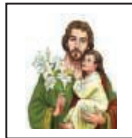

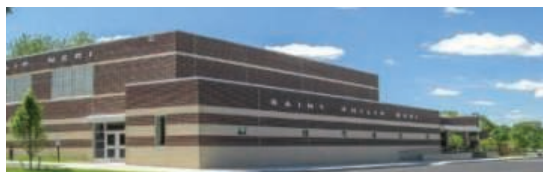
