



Dear St. Philip Neri Families & Friends

We give praise and thanks to God for the graces He has given us. Today we celebrate the Solemnity of Corpus Christi-The Body and Blood of Jesus Christ.

We are presented with a profound and mysterious teaching from the Gospel of John. Jesus speaks to the crowds about the true meaning of “the Bread of Life.” Jesus says, “I am the living bread that comes down from heaven. Whoever eats this bread will live forever. This bread is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world.” These words of Jesus may sound shocking and puzzling to us, just as they did to the people of His time. But let us delve into their deeper meaning and significance. First and foremost, Jesus identifies Himself as the source of eternal life. Through Him, we can partake in divine nourishment beyond the physical realm. Holy Communion, which is His flesh, is not an ordinary bread that perishes with time, but a spiritual sustenance that grants us everlasting life. When Jesus speaks about eating His flesh and drinking His blood, He uses symbolic language pointing to the Holy Eucharist’s institution. He invites us to partake in a profound and intimate union with Him. Just as we physically consume food and drink to sustain our bodies, so too are we called to receive Jesus into the depths of our souls, allowing His life to flow through us. In the Holy Communion, we encounter the real presence of Christ, where bread and wine are transformed into His body and blood. It is through this sacred meal that we are united with Jesus in a unique way, receiving the very essence of His sacrifice on the cross. By sharing in His body and blood, we become one with Him and are nourished spiritually, growing in holiness and grace. The Holy Communion is not a mere symbol or a representation of Jesus’ sacrifice. It is a profound mystery that surpasses our limited human understanding. In this sacrament, we encounter the depth of God’s love and His desire to be in communion with us. It is an invitation to enter into a living relationship with Christ, to be transformed by His presence, and to share in the life-giving grace He offers. As we contemplate these words of Jesus, let us approach the Holy Eucharist with awe and reverence. Let us recognize the tremendous gift that is being offered to us, the gift of His very self. May we never take this gift for granted but approach it with hearts full of faith and gratitude.

Anointing of the Sick

Primarily intended as prayers for healing from serious illness or as a spiritual preparation before surgery, it can involve multiple sacraments; Penance, Anointing & Eucharist. When death is imminent, it serves as "Last Rites" which include a special Apostolic Pardon. Please do not delay in calling for your elderly or chronically ill family member.
Call the Church Office to schedule an anointing.



Sacrament of Baptism

Baptisms are scheduled for the 2nd & 4th Sunday of every month immediately following the 11:30AM Mass. For first time parents, Pre-Jordan classes are required. Deacon Mike Cipressi conducts these classes via zoom appointments, they are offered on the 2nd Monday of the month. Godparents are required to obtain Letters of Eligibility; these letters are due at the Parish Office at least one week before the scheduled baptismal date. Call the Church Office at 610-834-1975 to schedule a Baptism and/or to register for the Pre-Jordan Class.



Sacrament of Marriage

Arrangements must be made with a priest at least 6 months prior to your desired wedding date. A Pre-Cana Class is required and held here at St. Philip's twice per year, usually in the spring and again in the fall. Development of Your Baby / My heart is Beating!

Your baby is making progress developing all of her external features and internal organs. Her brain is functioning at 40 days. Her mother can hear her heartbeat now on an ultrasonic stethoscope. Baby teeth buds are present at 6 1/2 weeks. The central nervous system is functioning and 40 muscle sets begin their first exercises. From this moment, your spiritually adopted baby grows and refines her body. But everything she needs to survive after birth is already present by the end of the eighth week.
