

**Dear St. Philip Neri Families & Friends**

We give praise and thanks to God for the graces He has given us. In today’s Gospel we encounter Jesus, the compassionate and merciful Shepherd, calling forth His disciples to join Him in His divine mission. As we delve into these verses, we are reminded of the immense love of our Savior and the significance of our role as His followers in today’s world. The passage begins with Jesus, moved by deep compassion for the people, recognizing their spiritual needs and the struggles they face. He sees them as sheep without a shepherd, wandering aimlessly, and in desperate need of guidance and care. It is this compassion that drives Jesus to action and compels Him to summon His disciples, to share in His divine work of healing and proclaiming the good news of the kingdom. It is a call to surrender our own self-sufficiency, to acknowledge our need for God’s provision, and to trust that He will provide for us as we engage in His work. May the words of Jesus resonate within our hearts, inspiring us to go forth as His disciples, filled with compassion and empowered by His authority. May our lives be a testament to His love, as we reach out to those who are lost, broken, and in need of the Good Shepherd. ## Church Roof Update

**Parishioners have raised over \$100,000! This combined with your past monthly generosity to the Capital Replacement Fund has made the project possible without incurring debt. The project will start at the end of the month and last 5-6 weeks. Access to the Church will be kept clear but just be aware of dumpsters, roofing materials, etc as you enter the parking lot.**

## Father's Day Cards

Cards are at the doors of the Church for living and deceased fathers. Their intentions will be remembered at all Masses on Father's Day will be offered for them as well as Masses said during the month of June. Please fill in the information on the enclosed envelope provided and drop it in the collection basket or in the church office. The card may be given to your father on Father's Day or if your father is deceased, keep it as a keepsake.



### **Anointing of the Sick**

Primarily intended as prayers for healing from serious illness or as a spiritual preparation before surgery, it can involve multiple sacraments; Penance, Anointing & Eucharist. When death is imminent, it serves as “Last Rites” which include a special Apostolic Pardon. Please do not delay in calling for your elderly or chronically ill family member. Call the Church Office to schedule an anointing.



### **Sacrament of Baptism**

Baptisms are scheduled for the 2<sup>nd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of every month immediately following the 11:30AM Mass. For first time parents, Pre-Jordan classes are required. Deacon Mike Cipressi conducts these classes via zoom appointments, they are offered on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Monday of the month. Godparents are required to obtain Letters of Eligibility; these letters are due at the Parish Office at least one week before the scheduled baptismal date. Call the Church Office at 610-834-1975 to schedule a Baptism and/or to register for the Pre-Jordan Class.



### **Sacrament of Marriage**

Arrangements must be made with a priest at least 6 months prior to your desired wedding date. A Pre-Cana Class is required and held here at St. Philip’s twice per year, usually in the spring and again in the fall. Please call the Church Office at 610-834-1975 to schedule a meeting with a priest and to obtain information on the Pre-Cana Class. Liturgy and musical planning are done through Mrs. Jean Martin our Director of Music (215-704-0508).




