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Dear St. Philip Neri Families & Friends

We give praise and thanks to God for the graces He has given us. Today's Gospel reading from Matthew presents us with a profound and comforting message from our Lord Jesus Christ.

In these verses, Jesus speaks of rest and relief for the weary souls who find solace in Him. Let us delve into this passage and reflect on the invitation Jesus extends to each one of us.

Jesus begins by acknowledging the Father's wisdom and how it is hidden from the 'wise and the learned.' He reveals that it is to the childlike, those with hearts open to receive, that the mysteries of the Kingdom of God are made known. The invitation to enter into the divine wisdom and understanding is not limited to the most knowledgeable scholars. Instead, Jesus calls upon humble and receptive hearts, those willing to approach God with simplicity and trust. Moreover, Jesus assures us that the weary and burdened can find rest in Him.

He acknowledges the challenges and hardships we face in our lives. We often carry burdens of various kinds – emotional, physical, and spiritual. Our lives can be overwhelmed by worries, anxieties, and the demands of our daily responsibilities. Jesus promises that He is the source of true rest, offering relief to our weary souls. Jesus invites us to come to Him, to yoke ourselves to Him. In the ancient agricultural context, the yoke was a wooden beam placed on the necks of oxen to help them bear the weight of their labor together. In the same way, Jesus offers us His yoke- a yoke of love, grace, and mercy. By yoking ourselves to Him, we join in a partnership with our Savior, who shares the weight of our burdens, lightening our load. He walks beside us, guiding us, and sustaining us with His loving presence. When we embrace the yoke of Christ, we discover not only rest but also a new way of life. Jesus assures us that His yoke is easy and His burden light. It is not the burden of the world, the burden of sin and self-reliance. Instead, it is the burden of discipleship, or surrendering ourselves to His will and allowing Him to lead us on the path of righteousness and holiness. In this passage, Jesus reminds us that humility, simplicity, and trust are the keys to finding rest in Him. Let us remember the profound truth that the God of the universe invites us to enter into an intimate relationship with Him, promising us rest and relief from our weariness. He offers us His wisdom and understanding, freely and generously, to those who approach Him with childlike faith. As we reflect on these words of Jesus, let us examine our own lives. Are we carrying heavy burdens that we have not surrendered to Christ? Are we seeking rest and solace in worldly pursuits rather than turning to the One who offers true rest for our souls? Let us come to Jesus today, with all our weariness and burdens, and place our trust in Him. He alone can grant us the peace that surpasses all understanding. May we heed the invitation of our Lord Jesus Christ and find solace in Him, knowing that in His yoke, we shall find rest for our souls. Let us pray for the grace to approach Him with childlike faith and embrace His teachings and His love. Through His guidance and support, may we live lives that bear witness to His mercy and grace, bringing light and hope to a world in need.

Church Roof Update

The project has started, scaffolding is in place and removal of the old roof has begun. The scale of the project will require 5-6 weeks to complete. This is not just re-shingling, but applying sub roofing and insulation and installing new downspouts and gutters as well. Access to the Church will be kept clear but just be aware of scaffolding, dumpsters, roofing materials, etc as you enter the parking lot and Church. Thank you!

Anointing of the Sick

Primarily intended as prayers for healing from serious illness or as a spiritual preparation before surgery, it can involve multiple sacraments; Penance, Anointing & Eucharist. When death is imminent, it serves as "Last Rites" which include a special Apostolic Pardon. Please do not delay in calling for your elderly or chronically ill family member. Call the Church Office to schedule an anointing.



Sacrament of Baptism

Baptisms are scheduled for the 2nd & 4th Sunday of every month immediately following the 11AM Mass. For first time parents, Pre-Jordan classes are required. Deacon Mike Cipressi conducts these classes via zoom appointments, they are offered on the 2nd Monday of the month. Godparents are required to obtain Letters of Eligibility; these letters are due at the Parish Office at least one week before the scheduled baptismal date. Call the Church Office at 610-834-1975 to schedule a Baptism and/or to register for the Pre-Jordan Class.



Sacrament of Marriage

Arrangements must be made with a priest at least 6 months prior to your desired wedding date, contact the Church Office at 610-834-1975 to schedule. The Archdiocese requires that couples attend a Pre-Cana class before marriage. At this time, we ask you to go to www.archphila.org, under marriage preparations to take class on line. Liturgy and musical planning are done through Mrs. Jean Martin our Director of Music (215-704-0508).

Spiritual Adoption Update

Your baby is quite active in the womb now...although the mother won't feel him for another couple of months. If his mother's womb had a window, you could watch your spiritually adopted baby aquint, swallow and move his tongue. He can make a tight fist if you touch his palm. He is breathing amniotic fluid which continues until birth, although he obtains oxygen his body needs through the umbilical cord. The baby you are praying for weighhs one ounce. Early this month, at just 9 weeks, he began to suck his thumb.

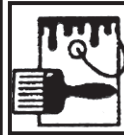
Retrouvaille

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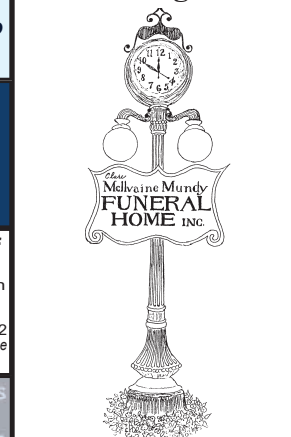
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
