Dear St. Philip Neri Families & Friends

As we celebrate the feast of the Transfiguration of our Lord

Jesus Christ, we are invited to embark on a journey of reflection and spiritual renewal. The Transfiguration event holds profound significance in our Catholic faith, revealing to us the glory of Christ and offering insights into our own

spiritual transformation. Let us take this opportunity to contemplate its meaning and discern how we can embrace

the transfigured Christ within ourselves. On the mountaintop, the disciples' witness the transfiguration of Jesus – a glimpse of His divinity shining forth in radiant glory. In this moment, Christ reveals His true identity as

God's beloved Son, fulfilling the prophecies of old. This revelation reminds us that Jesus is not merely a great teacher or prophet but the promised Messiah, worthy of our complete devotion and surrender. In our lives, we are often

challenged by doubt, fear, and uncertainty. The Transfiguration reminds us to embrace God's glory in our daily struggles, recognizing that we have a source of strength and hope to overcome our challenges in Christ. It is through embracing our faith in Christ that we can find

purpose and meaning in our journey on earth. The transfigured Christ not only reveals His divine nature but also calls us to undergo a transformation ourselves. Just as Jesus' appearance changed on the mountain, so too are we

called to be transformed by His love and grace. St. Paul reminds us in his letter to the Corinthians that we are being transformed into the likeness of Christ through the work of the Holy Spirit (2 Cor 3:18). As we encounter Christ in the Eucharist and in the Word of God, we are invited to open our hearts to His transformative power. Our encounters with Christ in prayer, the sacraments, and acts of charity can transfigure us, purifying us from sin, and shaping us to be more compassionate and loving. As the disciples experienced the awe-inspiring moment of Christ's transfiguration, they were eventually called to descend from the mountain and return to the world below.

Similarly, our moments of spiritual enlightenment and encounters with God are meant to equip us for our mission in the world. We are called to carry the light of Christ's transfigured presence into the ordinary moments of our lives, shining brightly amidst the darkness, and bringing hope to those we encounter. The Transfiguration reminds

us that we are all invited to experience a profound encounter with the Christ. Through the grace of the Transfiguration, may we grow in holiness and be empowered to radiate God's love to all we meet, so that through us, others may catch a glimpse of the transfigured Christ dwelling within our hearts. Anointing of the Sick

Primarily intended as prayers for healing from serious illness or as a spiritual preparation before surgery, it can involve multiple sacraments; Penance, Anointing & Eucharist. When death is imminent, it serves as "Last Rites" which include a special Apostolic Pardon. Please do not delay in calling for your elderly or chronically ill family member.
 Call the Church Office to schedule an anointing.



Sacrament of Baptism

Baptisms are scheduled for the 2nd & 4th Sunday of every month immediately following the 11AM Mass. For first time parents, Pre-Jordan classes are required. Deacon Mike Cipressi conducts these classes via zoom appointments, they are offered on the 2nd Monday of the month. Godparents are required to obtain Letters of Eligibility; these letters are due at the Parish Office at least one week before the scheduled baptismal date. Call the Church Office at 610-834-1975 to schedule a Baptism and/or to register for the Pre-Jordan Class.



Sacrament of Marriage

Arrangements must be made with a priest at least 6 months prior to your desired wedding date, contact the Church Office at 610-834-1975 to schedule. The Archdiocese requires that couples attend a Pre-Cana class before marriage. At this time, we ask you to go to www.archphila.org, under marriage preparations to take class on line. Liturgy and musical planning are done through Mrs. Jean Martin our Director of Music (215-704-0508).

Spiritual Adoption Update

Your baby is quite active in the womb now...although the mother won't feel him for another couple of months. If his mother's womb had a window, you could watch your spiritually adopted baby squint, swallow and move his tongue. He can make a tight fist if you touch his palm. He is breathing amniotic fluid which continues until birth, although he obtains oxygen his body needs through the umbilical cord. The baby you are praying for weighs one ounce. Early this month, at just 9 weeks, he began to suck his thumb.

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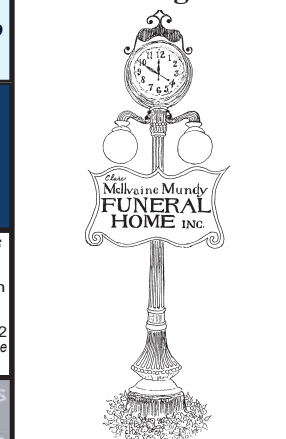
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
