Dear St. Philip Neri Families & Friends

We give praise and thanks to God for the graces He has given us. The Scriptures often call us to a profound transformation of heart and mind, inviting us to align our lives with God's divine plan. In this reflection, we'll explore the interconnected messages of surrender, self-denial, and transformation found in Matthew 16:21-27 and Romans 12:1-2. Jesus' words in Matthew 16:21-27 reveal the essence of Christian discipleship-embracing the cross.

As Jesus foretells His passion, Peter's well-intentioned objection elicits a stern response: "Get behind me, Satan! You are an obstacle to me." Jesus underscores that His path involves suffering and sacrifice. To follow Him, we must deny ourselves, take up our cross, and walk in His footsteps. Paul's exhortation in Romans 12:1-2 complements the message of Matthew 16. "I urge you, brothers and sisters, by the mercies of God, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God, your spiritual worship. Do not conform yourselves to this age but be transformed by the renewal of your mind." Here, Paul urges us to surrender our lives to God allowing His transformative grace to renew our minds. Both passages underscore the call to surrender-surrendering our desires, plans, and worldly attachments to God. In Matthew 16, Jesus models this surrender through His obedience to the Father's will. In Roman's 12, Paul emphasizes that our surrender is a living sacrifice, a continual offering of our lives to God. True discipleship begins when we relinquish control and place our trust in God's providence. Denying

ourselves means letting go of ego, pride, and self-centeredness. In doing so, we create space for God's transformative power. This denial opens us to God's grace, enabling us to experience the freedom and joy of living in accordance with His plan. Denying self is not about self-neglect but allowing God to shape us into vessels of His love. Renewal of the mind, as Paul describes, is a process of inner transformation. It involves aligning our thoughts, values, and perspectives with God's truth. This renewal occurs through prayer, Scripture, the sacraments, and a willingness to be receptive to the Holy Spirit's guidance. A renewed mind enables us to discern God's will and respond with faithfulness. Matthew 16:21-27 and Romans 12:1-2

present a holistic perspective on discipleship and transformation. As we reflect on the call to deny ourselves, take up our cross, surrender to God's will, and renew our minds, we are reminded That following Christ is a journey of ongoing conversion. Embracing the cross and renewing the mind are intertwined, each nurturing the other. May we need these calls, allowing God's grace to shape us into true disciples who bear witness to His transformative love in the world.

Anointing of the Sick

Primarily intended as prayers for healing from serious illness or as a spiritual preparation before surgery, it can involve multiple sacraments; Penance, Anointing & Eucharist. When death is imminent, it serves as "Last Rites" which include a special Apostolic Pardon. Please do not delay in calling for your elderly or chronically ill family member.

Sacrament of Baptism

Baptisms are scheduled for the 2nd & 4th Sunday of every month immediately following the 11AM Mass. For first time parents, Pre-Jordan classes are required. Deacon Mike Cipressi conducts these classes via zoom appointments, they are offered on the 2nd Monday of the month. Godparents are required to obtain Letters of Eligibility; these letters are due at the Parish Office at least one week before the scheduled baptismal date.
