### Dear St. Philip Neri Families & Friends

We give praise and thanks to God for the graces He has given us. In this Sunday's reflection on the readings, we delve into the profound themes of forgiveness, mercy, and reconciliation found in the Book of Sirach and the

Gospel of Matthew. Both readings emphasize the importance of forgiving others as God forgives us, reminding us of the boundless love and mercy of our Heavenly Father. The words from the Book of Sirach challenge us to confront the destructive nature of anger, resentment, and unforgiveness. These emotions not only harm others but also tarnish our relationship with God.

When we harbor grudges and seek vengeance, we distance ourselves from God's mercy. The passage invites us to a profound truth: by forgiving others, we open the door to receiving forgiveness from God. In our Gospel passage this week, Peter asks Jesus about the limits of forgiveness, proposing seven times as a generous measure. However, Jesus responds with a radical call for boundless forgiveness. The parable that follows reinforces this message: a servant who is forgiven an enormous debt fails to show the same mercy to a fellow servant with a much smaller debt. The master's response serves as a warning that we, too, must forgive others from our hearts if we expect God's forgiveness. As Catholics, we are called to be living witnesses of God's mercy and forgiveness. These bible readings remind us of the imperative to let go of anger, resentment, and the desire for revenge. Instead, we should strive to emulate God's infinite forgiveness and mercy in our interactions with others.

**Reflect on your own heart:** Take a moment to examine your heart. Are there grudges or resentments you've been holding on to? Ask God for the grace to release these burdens, knowing that by forgiving others, you open yourself to God's forgiveness.

**Pray for the strength to forgive:** Forgiveness can be challenging, especially when the hurt is deep. Pray for strength and grace to forgive those who have wronged you.

Even when it feels difficult.

**Model Christ's forgiveness:** Remember that Christ forgave us despite our sins. Strive to extend that same forgiveness to others, demonstrating Christ's love and mercy through your actions.

**Seek Reconciliation:** If possible, take steps towards reconciling with those you have conflicts. Jesus encourages us to go and reconcile with our brothers and sisters before offering our gifts at the altar (MT 5:23-24).

In conclusion, the first reading from Sirach and Gospel from Matthew reminds us that forgiveness is not just a noble virtue but a fundamental aspect of our faith. By forgiving others, we align ourselves with God's boundless love and mercy, drawing closer to Him and reflecting His grace in the world.

Please invite someone to Mass. St. Philip Neri pray for us! Please pray for me, have a blessed week!

## Anointing of the Sick




