Dear St. Philip Neri Families & Friends



We give praise and thanks to God for the graces He has given us. In Psalm 18 this week, we find words of praise and thanksgiving to the Lord, the source of strength and deliverance. As Catholics, we often recite and reflect upon the words of the Psalms, recognizing them as a powerful expression of human emotion and faith. The imagery in this Psalm reminds us of the profound relationship we share with our loving God. He is our rock, our fortress, our deliverer – a steadfast presence in our lives. The psalmist's words echo the central theme of our faith, as reiterated by Jesus in the Gospel reading from Matthew. When asked about the greatest commandment, Jesus responds by quoting the Old Testament; "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind." This commandment is the foundation of our personal relationship with God. It calls us to wholeheartedly dedicate ourselves to God, seeking refuge in His love, just as the psalmist sought refuge in God as his stronghold. But Jesus doesn't stop there. He goes on to emphasize another crucial aspect of our faith; "A second is like it; you shall love your neighbor as yourself." This commandment reveals the interconnectedness of our love for God and love for one another. We cannot claim to love God fully if we do not extend that love to all of God's children. In this union of these two great commandments, we find the essence of Christian life. Our faith is not solely about personal piety or ritual, but about a profound love that encompasses both our God and His children. We are called to see the divine image in every person, to treat our neighbors with the same love and respect we offer to God. This can be challenging at times and in those instances, we need to look to God for His grace to respond with love and mercy. The Psalms remind us that God is our stronghold in times of trouble, our shield from the storms of life. In the Gospel, Jesus teaches us that to love God and neighbor is to build a foundation of faith so strong that it upholds all the laws of God and teachings of the Prophets. As we meditate on these passages, let us remember that our faith is not just about individual salvation, but about having a deep personal relationship with God and living in a loving community with all of God's children. Let us seek refuge in the Lord, our rock and fortress, and strive to live out the love He calls us to by loving both Him and our neighbors with all our heart, soul, and mind.



Anointing of the Sick

Primarily intended as prayers for healing from serious illness or as a spiritual preparation before surgery, it can involve multiple sacraments; Penance, Anointing & Eucharist. When death is imminent, it serves as "Last Rites" which include a special Apostolic Pardon. Please do not delay in calling for your elderly or chronically ill family member. Call the Church Office to schedule an anointing.



Sacrament of Baptism

Baptisms are scheduled for the 2nd & 4th Sunday of every month immediately following the 11AM Mass. For first time parents, Pre-Jordan classes are required. Deacon Mike Cipressi conducts these classes via zoom appointments, they are offered on the 2nd Monday of the month. Godparents are required to obtain Letters of Eligibility; these letters are due at the Parish Office at least one week before the scheduled baptismal date. 
