### Dear St. Philip Neri Families & Friends



We give praise and thanks to God for the graces He has given us. As we reflect upon the sacred days of All Saint's and All Soul's Day, our hearts are drawn to contemplate the suffering souls in purgatory, those beloved departed who are in need of our prayers and intercession and the saints in heaven praising God. These two days, closely linked in the Catholic liturgical calendar, offer us a profound opportunity to reflect upon the concept of purgatory and the importance of praying for the suffering souls undergoing purification. Purgatory, as taught by the Catholic Church, is a temporary state in which souls who have died in a state of grace, yet with attachments to sin and imperfections, are purified and made ready for the glory of heaven. It is a place of God's mercy and justice, a place where His love and infinite compassion are manifest. The suffering souls in purgatory are our brothers and sisters, and they are enduring a purifying fire that burns away the remnants of sin, enabling them to stand in the presence of our Living God. All Saint's Day, celebrated on November 1<sup>st</sup>, reminds us of the great multitude of holy men and women who have gone before us and now enjoy the fullness of God's presence in heaven. They are known as the Church Triumphant. These saints are our role models, our intercessors, and our special companions. They serve as beacons of hope and inspiration, show us that the path to holiness is attainable, even amidst the trials and temptations of this world. Our God keeps His promise to His faithful sons and daughters. All Soul's Day, observed on November 2<sup>nd</sup>, is a day dedicated to remembering and praying for all the suffering souls in purgatory. They are known as the Church Suffering. It is a day of profound significance, for it underscores our responsibility to assist our departed loved ones on their journey toward heavenly perfection. Through our prayers, sacrifices, and acts of charity, we can alleviate the suffering of the poor souls in purgatory and hasten their entry into God's Heavenly Kingdom. The importance of praying for the suffering souls in purgatory cannot be overstated. Our prayers offer comfort, relief, and hope to those who long for the embrace of God. When we pass the cemetery, we should always offer a prayer for the souls in purgatory. Through our intercession, we participate in the Communion of Saints, a spiritual unity that transcends time and space. Our prayers can help speed up the purgatorial process and bring solace to the souls who long for the joy of heaven. In my family as in many other families we were always taught to remember and pray for the suffering souls in purgatory. I remember many times when my mom made a meal we did not care for or asked to do something we were not quick to do. My mom would always say "offer it up to the suffering souls in purgatory" (tell me that was not using Catholic guilt!). In praying for the poor souls in purgatory, we practice the theological virtue of charity. We extend our love and compassion beyond the boundaries of this earthly life, demonstrating the universality of the Church and the power of Christian charity. By doing so, we bear witness to the mercy and love of God, who desires the salvation and

sanctification of all His children. This All Saints' and All Souls' Day, let us remember the suffering souls with hearts full of love and compassion. Let us offer our prayers, sacrifices, and Mass intentions for their benefit. By doing so, we become instruments of God's mercy and play a crucial role in the spiritual journey of our departed loved ones. Through our prayers, may these souls be purified, and may they soon join the glorious company of the saints in the eternal joy of heaven. For one day we may be there relying on those on earth to remember to pray for our souls.



### **Anointing of the Sick**

Primarily intended as prayers for healing from serious illness or as a spiritual preparation before surgery, it can involve multiple sacraments; Penance, Anointing & Eucharist. When death is imminent, it serves as "Last Rites" which include a special Apostolic Pardon. Please do not delay in calling for your elderly or chronically ill family member. Call the Church Office to schedule an anointing.

Baptisms are scheduled for the 2<sup>nd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of every month immediately following the 11AM Mass. For first time parents, Pre-Jordan classes are required. Deacon Mike Cipressi conducts these classes via zoom appointments, they are offered on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Monday of the month. Godparents are required to obtain Letters of Eligibility; these letters are due at the Parish Office at least one week before the scheduled baptismal date.
