Dear St. Philip Neri Families & Friends



We give praise and thanks to God for the graces He has given us. As we approach the conclusion of the Liturgical Year, the 33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time calls us to reflect on the theme of vigilance and preparedness for the second coming of Christ. The Gospel reading from Matthew 25:14-30 presents the well-known Parable of the Talents, where a master entrusts different amounts of talents to his servants before going away. The response of each servant upon the master's return becomes the gauge of their faithfulness and stewardship.

In this parable, we see a master who generously distributes his wealth, symbolizing the varied gifts and abilities God grants to each one of us. The servants who invest and multiply these talents are commended, while the one buries his talents out of fear faces consequences. This parable reminds us that God has entrusted us with unique gifts – whether they be skills, resources, or opportunities – and He expects us to use them for the growth of His kingdom. This Sunday serves as a poignant reminder that we are living in the tension between the “already” and the “not yet”. Christ has come, died, and risen, inaugurating the Kingdom of God, yet we await His second coming when the Kingdom will be fully realized. In the meantime, we are called to be faithful stewards, actively participating in the ongoing work of God's redemptive plan. As we reflect on the Parable of the Talents, we are prompted to examine our lives. How are we using the gifts and opportunities God has given us? Are we actively engaged in building up

God's Kingdom on earth, or are we, out of fear or complacency, burying our talents? This Gospel challenges us to overcome the paralysis of fear and embrace a courageous and active faith. It encourages us to step out of our comfort zones, take risks for the sake of the Gospel, and invest our talents in ways that bear fruit for God's glory. On this 33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time, may we be inspired by the faithful servants who joyfully invested their talents, and may we heed the call to live as vigilant and active disciples. As we await the glorious return of our Master, let us, with gratitude and zeal, use our God-given talents to bring about His kingdom in our hearts and in the world around us. May our lives echo the words of the Master, “well done, good and faithful servant! Enter into the joy of your master”

(Matthew 25:21). I will be praying for you and your family to have a blessed and joyful Thanksgiving. If you are traveling this Thanksgiving, may God's angels and saints watch over you.

Sacrament of Marriage

Arrangements must be made with a priest at least 6 months prior to your desired wedding date, contact the Church Office at 610-834-1975 to schedule. The Archdiocese requires that couples attend a Pre-Cana class before marriage. At this time, we ask you to go to www.archphila.org, under marriage preparations to take class on line.



Anointing of the Sick

Primarily intended as prayers for healing from serious illness or as a spiritual preparation before surgery, it can involve multiple sacraments; Penance, Anointing & Eucharist. When death is imminent, it serves as "Last Rites" which include a special Apostolic Pardon. Please do not delay in calling for your elderly or chronically ill family member. Call the Church Office to schedule an anointing.



Sacrament of Baptism

Baptisms are scheduled for the 2nd & 4th Sunday of every month immediately following the 11AM Mass. For first time parents, Pre-Jordan classes are required. Deacon Mike Cipressi conducts these classes via zoom appointments, they are offered on the 2nd Monday of the month. Godparents are required to obtain Letters of Eligibility; these letters are due at the Parish Office at least one week before the scheduled baptismal date. Call the Church Office at 610-834-1975 to schedule a Baptism and/or to register for the Pre-Jordan Class.

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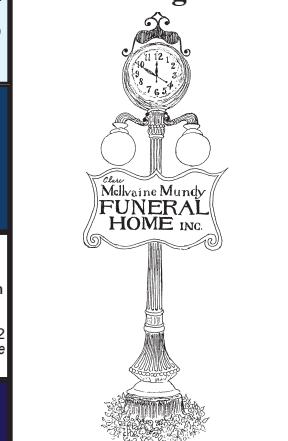
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
