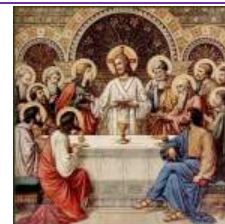

Dear St. Philip Neri Families & Friends



We give praise and thanks to God for the graces He has given. As we light the first candle on the Advent Wreath, we embark on a sacred journey of anticipation and preparation. The liturgical season of Advent calls us to pause, reflect, and open our hearts to the coming of Christ. The First Sunday in Advent invites us to focus on the theme of hope. In the midst of a world often marked by uncertainty and turmoil, we are reminded that our hope is anchored in the promises of God. The prophet Isaiah, whose words echo through the ages, speaks of a future filled with the light of the Lord. "Come, let us walk in the light of the Lord!" (Isaiah 2:5) As we meditate on the Scripture readings for today, we are called to examine our hearts and ask ourselves: What does it mean to hope in the Lord? How can we cultivate a spirit of joyful expectation as we await the celebration of the Incarnation? St. Philip Neri would like that. Advent is not merely a countdown to Christmas; it is a season of spiritual preparation. It is a time to prepare the way for the Lord in our hearts, making room for Jesus amidst the busyness of our lives. The Gospel reading reminds us of the importance of staying awake and alert, for we do not know the day or the hour when the Son of Man will come (Matthew 24:37-44). This vigilance is not one of fear, but of hope and readiness. In the hustle and bustle of the season, let us carve out moments of stillness and prayer. Let us reflect on the blessings of the past year, acknowledging God's faithfulness, and surrendering our worries and anxieties to Him. As we wait in hope, may we also actively engage in acts of kindness and charity, becoming beacons of Christ's love in a world that hungers for hope and peace. The Advent Wreath, with its first candle aglow, symbolizes the flicker of hope that dispels the darkness. As we gaze upon this flame, may it serve as a tangible reminder of the Light that is to come. Let us journey through Advent with hearts full of hope, trusting in the promise of Emmanuel, God with us.

Sacrament of Marriage

Arrangements must be made with a priest at least 6 months prior to your desired wedding date, contact the Church Office at 610-834-1975 to schedule. The Archdiocese requires that couples attend a Pre-Cana class before marriage. At this time, we ask you to go to www.archphila.org, under marriage preparations to take class on line. Liturgy and musical planning are done through Mrs. Jean Martin our Director of Music (215-704-0508).



Anointing of the Sick

Primarily intended as prayers for healing from serious illness or as a spiritual preparation before surgery, it can involve multiple sacraments; Penance, Anointing & Eucharist. When death is imminent, it serves as "Last Rites" which include a special Apostolic Pardon. Please do not delay in calling for your elderly or chronically ill family member. Call the Church Office to schedule an anointing.



Sacrament of Baptism

Baptisms are scheduled for the 2nd & 4th Sunday of every month immediately following the 11AM Mass. For first time parents, Pre-Jordan classes are required. Deacon Mike Cipressi conducts these classes via zoom appointments, they are offered on the 2nd Monday of the month. Godparents are required to obtain Letters of Eligibility; these letters are due at the Parish Office at least one week before the scheduled baptismal date. Call the Church Office at 610-834-1975 to schedule a Baptism and/or to register for the Pre-Jordan Class.



Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is for individuals interested in exploring and discerning membership in the Catholic Church. This program is for non-Catholics who may or may not have been baptized in another Christian Church and wish to receive the Sacraments of Penance, Confirmation and Holy Eucharist. It is also for those who were baptized in the Catholic Church but never received the other Sacraments of Initiation. Call Barney McGee in the Church office at 610-834-1975 for more information.

Advent and Advent Wreath



The word "advent" comes from the Latin "adventus" meaning coming or arrival. Its beginnings date back to 380AD when it is mentioned at the Council of Saragossa. It essentially has a threefold purpose; prepare for the birth of Christ, celebrate our faith in Christ, and joyful anticipation of His Resurrection. The Advent Wreath seems to be German in origin with its use of evergreens symbolizing immortality. The four candles have meaning as well. The first for hope, called the Prophecy Candle, the second for peace, called the Bethlehem Candle, the third for joy, called the Shepherd's Candle and the fourth for love, called the Angel's Candle. A wonderful symbol to focus our hearts on the coming glory of the Incarnation.

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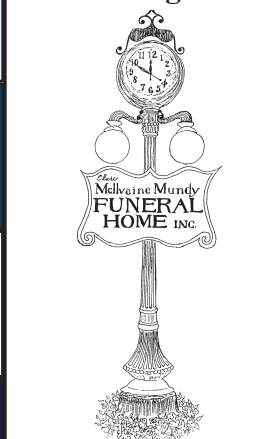
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
