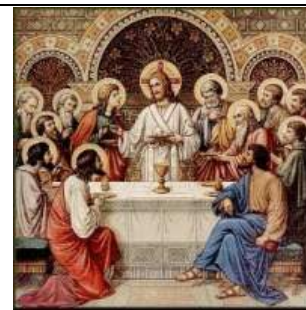

Dear St. Philip Neri Families & Friends



We give praise and thanks to God for the graces He has given us. As we gather for Mass on this Third Sunday in Ordinary Time, the Scriptures invite us to reflect on the theme of responding to God's call. The readings present the image of light breaking through the darkness, symbolizing the presence of Christ and His invitation to follow Him. In the first reading (Jonah 3:1-5, 10), we encounter Jonah, a reluctant prophet who initially resisted God's call but ultimately embraced it. Jonah's story reminds us that God's call may come unexpectedly, challenging us to leave our comfort zones and respond with faith. The psalm (Psalm 25:4-9) echoes the theme of guidance and humility. As we navigate the journey of life, we turn to God, seeking His direction and mercy. The psalmist teaches us to trust in God's ways and acknowledge our need for His guidance. The Gospel passage (Mark 1:14-20) narrates the calling of the first disciples. Jesus invites Simon, Andrew, James, and John to leave their nets and follow Him. Their immediate response illustrates the radical nature of discipleship – a willingness to leave behind the familiar and embrace the unknown for the sake of Christ. As we reflect on these readings, let us examine our own lives. Are we open to God's call, even if it disrupts our plans? Are we willing to let go of the security of our 'nets' and follow Christ with trust and obedience? The Third Sunday in Ordinary Time challenges us to be attentive to the ways in which God is calling us today. It encourages us to be like Peter, Andrew, James and John who, upon hearing the voice of Jesus, left everything to walk in His light. May we, too, embrace the call to discipleship with courage and faith, trusting that God's path leads to true fulfillment and eternal life.

Anointing of the Sick

Primarily intended as prayers for healing from serious illness or as a spiritual preparation before surgery, it can involve multiple sacraments; Penance, Anointing & Eucharist. When death is imminent, it serves as "Last Rites" which include a special Apostolic Pardon. Please do not delay in calling for your elderly or chronically ill family member. Call the Church Office to schedule an anointing.



Sacrament of Baptism

Baptisms are scheduled for the 2nd & 4th Sunday of every month immediately following the 11AM Mass. For first time parents, Pre-Jordan classes are required. Deacon Mike Cipressi conducts these classes via zoom appointments, they are offered on the 2nd Monday of the month. Godparents are required to obtain Letters of Eligibility; these letters are due at the Parish Office at least one week before the scheduled baptismal date. 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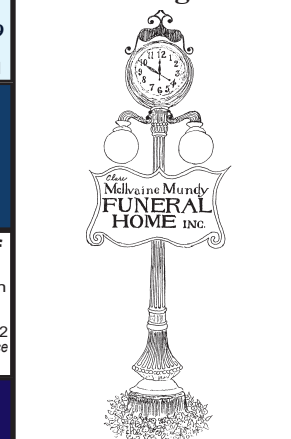
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
