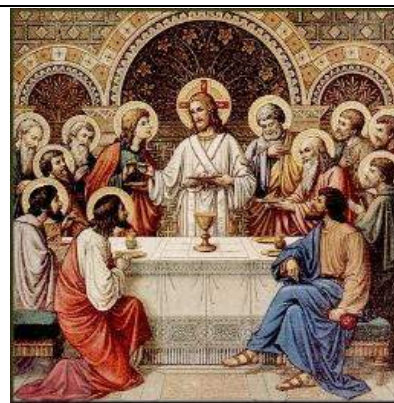

Dear St. Philip Neri Families & Friends



We give praise and thanks to God for the graces He has given us. As we embark on the sacred journey of Holy Lent, the season of reflection, penance, and preparation, the liturgy of the First Sunday invites us to enter the desert with Christ. In this solemn period, we are called to imitate Jesus, who spent forty days and nights fasting and praying in the wilderness, facing temptations from the adversary. The wilderness, both a physical and metaphorical space, symbolizes the challenges and trials we encounter in our spiritual lives. It is a place of solitude, where distractions fade away, and the raw essence of our relationship with God is laid bare. As we step into this symbolic desert during Lent, we are invited to confront our own temptations, weaknesses, and distractions that distance us from God. The Gospel reading recounts the temptations faced by Jesus, highlighting the vulnerability of humanity to the allure of power, prestige, and pleasure. Satan's cunning whispers echo through the ages, attempting to divert us from the path of righteousness. Yet Jesus' steadfast resistance serves as a beacon of hope, revealing that even in our weakness we can find strength through faith and reliance on God's grace. This season beckons us to embrace the disciplines of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. Through prayer, we open our hearts to God's guidance, seeking strength to resist the temptations that surround us. Fasting, not only from food but also from excesses of our modern lives, enables us to detach from worldly pleasures and draw nearer to God. Almsgiving challenges us to share our blessings with those in need, fostering a spirit of generosity and compassion. In the silence of the desert, we may encounter moments of discomfort and longing. However, it is precisely in these moments that we draw closer to God. As we navigate the Lenten wilderness, let us remember that Christ's victory over temptation paves the way for our own triumphs. The ashes we receive on Ash Wednesday are not just a mark of penance but a symbol of transformation, as we journey toward the Resurrection. May this Holy Lenten season be a time of profound spiritual renewal, where we turn away from the distractions of the world and fix our gaze upon Christ. In the desert of our lives, let us find solace in the promise of Easter, anticipating the joy that comes with the triumph of light over darkness. As we embark on this sacred pilgrimage, may our hearts be purified, our souls strengthened, and our faith deepened, ultimately bringing us closer to the glory of the Resurrection. Anointing of the Sick

Primarily intended as prayers for healing from serious illness or as a spiritual preparation before surgery, it can involve multiple sacraments; Penance, Anointing & Eucharist. When death is imminent, it serves as "Last Rites" which include a special Apostolic Pardon. Please do not delay in calling for your elderly or chronically ill family member. Call the Church Office to schedule an anointing.

Baptisms are scheduled for the 2nd & 4th Sunday of every month immediately following the 11AM Mass. For first time parents, Pre-Jordan classes are required. Deacon Mike Cipressi conducts these classes via zoom appointments, they are offered on the 2nd Monday of the month. Godparents are required to obtain Letters of Eligibility; these letters are due at the Parish Office at least one week before the scheduled baptismal date. 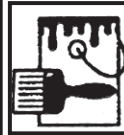
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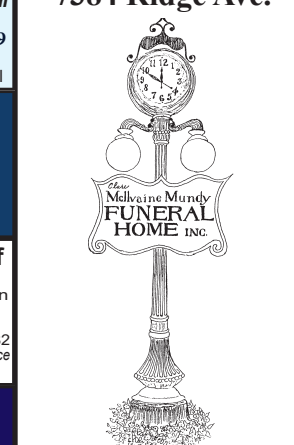
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
