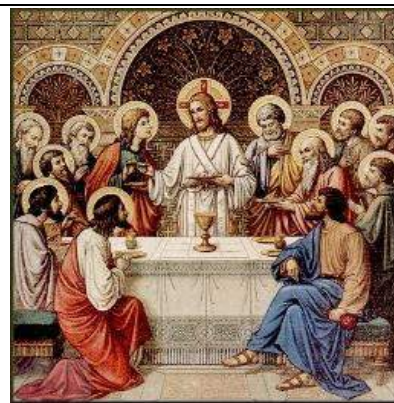

Dear St. Philip Neri Families & Friends



We give praise and thanks to God for the graces He has given us. As we journey through Holy Lent, the Second Sunday invites us to ascend the mountain with Jesus and witness the breathtaking moment of His Transfiguration. This pivotal event, recorded in the Gospels of Matthew, Mark, and Luke, provides a glimpse into the divine glory that resides within Christ, affirming His identity as the Beloved Son of God. On that mountain, Jesus was transfigured before the eyes of Peter, James, and John. His face shone like the sun, and His garments dazzling white. This celestial radiance revealed the divine nature of Christ, emphasizing his unique relationship with the Father. As we reflect on this profound encounter, we are called to contemplate the significance of the Transfiguration in our own Lenten journey. The mountain holds a special place in Scripture; it is a site of encounter with God. Abraham ascended Mount Moriah to offer his son Isaac, Moses received the Commandments on Mount Sinai, and now, Jesus reveals His divine glory on a mountain. Lent, too, is a metaphorical ascent, a call to draw closer to God through prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. In the Transfiguration, we find a foretaste of the Resurrection. As Jesus stands in radiant glory, conversing with Moses and Elijah, we witness the continuity of God's plan throughout salvation history. Moses represents the Law, Elijah, the prophets, and Jesus fulfills both. The Transfiguration affirms the seamless connection between the Old and New Testaments, highlighting Jesus as the fulfillment of God's promises.

Peter's response to this awe-inspiring moment is emblematic of our human inclination to cling to the extraordinary. He suggests building three tents, wanting to prolong the experience. However, the voice from the cloud instructs the disciples to listen to Jesus, directing them to follow His teachings and embrace the journey that leads to the Cross. As we navigate our Lenten path, the Transfiguration challenges us to seek moments of divine encounter in the ordinary aspects of our lives. The mountaintop experience is not an escape from reality but a transformative revelation that prepares us for the challenges that lie ahead. Lent calls us to listen to Jesus amidst the noise of the world, to allow His teachings to illuminate our hearts and guide our actions. In contemplating the Transfiguration, we are reminded that our Lenten journey is not one of despair but of hope. The radiant Christ invites us to persevere, assuring us that beyond the trials of the Cross, there is the glory of the Resurrection. As we continue our ascent through Holy Lent, may the Transfiguration inspire us to seek the divine in the ordinary, and may the radiant face of Christ guide us through the shadows, leading us toward the eternal light.

Primarily intended as prayers for healing from serious illness or as a spiritual preparation before surgery, it can involve multiple sacraments; Penance, Anointing & Eucharist. When death is imminent, it serves as "Last Rites" which include a special Apostolic Pardon. Please do not delay in calling for your elderly or chronically ill family member. Call the Church Office to schedule an anointing.



Sacrament of Baptism

Baptisms are scheduled for the 2nd & 4th Sunday of every month immediately following the 11AM Mass. For first time parents, Pre-Jordan classes are required. Deacon Mike Cipressi conducts these classes via zoom appointments, they are offered on the 2nd Monday of the month. Godparents are required to obtain Letters of Eligibility; these letters are due at the Parish Office at least one week before the scheduled baptismal date. 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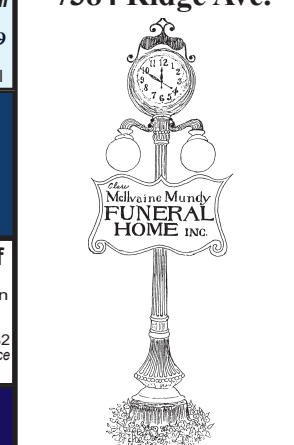
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
