## Dear St. Philip Neri Families & Friends



We give praise and thanks to God for the graces He has given us. Today, we gather to celebrate the glorious Solemnity of the Resurrection of Jesus Christ, our hearts are filled with joy and hope. For on this day, we commemorate the most profound event in human history, the Resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ. In the Gospel of John (20:1-9), we are reminded of the profound significance of this day. Mary Magdalene goes to the tomb early in the morning, only to find the stone rolled away and the tomb empty. Jesus' Resurrection assures us that God's love knows no bounds—it reaches out to the lost, the broken, and the downtrodden, offering them hope and renewal. The Resurrection of Jesus Christ is the cornerstone of our faith. It is a reminder that no matter how deep our sins or how overwhelming our struggles, there is always hope in Christ. His love knows no bounds, and His mercy is endless. Through His great sacrifice on the cross, Jesus has redeemed us and offered us the gift of salvation. As we celebrate Easter, let us reflect on the profound love that Jesus has for each and every one of us. He willingly endured the agony of the cross out of love for us, taking upon Himself the burden of our sins. His resurrection is a sign of His victory over sin and death, and it is a promise of new life for all who believe in Him.
