Dear St. Philip Neri Families & Friends



We give praise and thanks to God for the graces He has given us. In the Gospel of John, we encounter a powerful narrative that speaks directly to the essence of Divine Mercy Sunday. In John 20:19-31, we witness the profound encounter between the Risen Christ and His disciples, particularly the transformative exchange between Jesus and Thomas. Following His resurrection Jesus appears to His disciples who are gathered in fear behind locked doors. In this moment, Jesus doesn't chastise them for their fear or doubt, but instead offers them words of peace, "Peace be with you" John 20:19. This simple yet profound greeting embodies the essence of Divine Mercy – the unmerited gift of forgiveness and peace bestowed upon us by our loving Savior. However, Thomas, one of the disciples, is absent during this encounter. When told of Jesus' appearance, he expresses doubt, stating that he will only believe if he sees the wounds of Christ Himself. Jesus demonstrates His infinite mercy by appearing again, specifically to Thomas, inviting him to touch His wounds and believe. Jesus doesn't rebuke Thomas for his doubt, but lovingly invites him to faith, saying, "Do not doubt but believe" (John 20:27). Divine Mercy Sunday, instituted by St. John Paul II, falls on the Sunday after Easter, emphasizing the abundance of God's Mercy poured out upon humanity through the resurrection of Jesus Christ. It serves as a reminder of the limitless depths of God's love and forgiveness, calling us to embrace and share this mercy with others. Like the disciples, we often find ourselves imprisoned by fear, doubt, and sin. Yet, just as Jesus entered the locked room to offer peace to His disciples, Jesus enters into the depths of our hearts, offering us the gift of His Divine Mercy. Divine Mercy Sunday invites us to reflect on the reality of God's forgiveness and the transformative power it holds for our lives. In our brokenness, like Thomas, we may struggle to fully believe in God's mercy. We may question whether we are truly worthy of such forgiveness. Yet, Jesus extends His wounded hands to us, inviting us to encounter His mercy personally, to experience the healing balm of His love poured out for us on the cross. As we celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday, let us open our hearts to receive the abundance of God's mercy. Let us allow the Risen Christ to enter into the locked rooms of our lives, dispelling our fears and doubts with His peace. And let us, like Thomas, humbly profess our faith, declaring with conviction, "My Lord and my God!" (John 20:28). May Divine Mercy be a time of renewal and transformation, as we embrace the gift of forgiveness and extend that same mercy to others, embodying the love of the Risen Christ in our world today.

Sacraments

Baptism

Baptisms are scheduled on the 2nd & 4th Sunday of every month immediately following the 11AM Mass.

Marriage

Arrangements must be made with a priest at least 6 months prior to wedding date. Pre-Cana classes are required, contact Church office at 610-834-1975.

Anointing of the Sick

Primarily intended as prayers and anointing for healing from serious illness or as a spiritual preparation before surgery. Last Rites or Extreme Unction are for those in danger of imminent death.

Divine Mercy

St. Maria Faustina Kowalska, was a Polish Catholic nun and mystic in the 1920's & 30's. Her diary records 14 occasions when Jesus requested a Feast of Mercy. He appeared to her in a vision with His right hand raised in blessing and His left touching His garment above His heart. Red and white rays emanate from His heart, symbolizing the blood and water that poured out for our sanctification. Jesus asked that this image be painted and venerated throughout the world. Jesus said for sins acknowledged & confessed, "I do not want to punish aching mankind, but I desire to heal it, pressing it to my merciful heart." For more go to: www.thedivinemercy.org

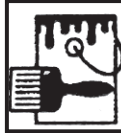

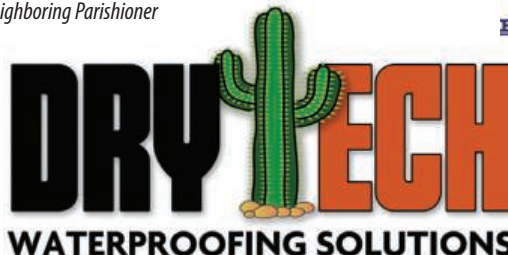
