Dear St. Philip Neri Families & Friends



We give praise and thanks to God for the graces He has given us! Christ has risen, Alleluia! He has risen indeed. Alleluia! As we gather on this Good Shepherd Sunday, our hearts are drawn to the image of Jesus as the Good Shepherd, who knows His sheep and lays down His life for them. It is a profound image that speaks to the very essence of our faith and the depth of God's love for each one of us. In today's Gospel, Jesus tells us, "I am the Good Shepherd. A good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep" (John 10:11). These words resonate with a timeless truth that continues to echo through the ages: the sacrificial love of Christ, who willingly gave His life for us, His flock.

On this World Day of Prayer for Vocations, we are reminded of our call to follow in the footsteps of the Good Shepherd. We are to be shepherds after His own heart, to care for one another with the same love and compassion that Christ has shown us. In a world filled with noise and distractions, it can be easy to lose sight of our vocation, our purpose in life. But today, we are invited to pause and listen attentively to the voice of the Good Shepherd, who calls each of us by name. He calls us to serve Him faithfully, whether as priests, religious brothers or sisters, or in the many other vocations within the Church. The shortage of priests is not just a statistic or a problem to be solved; it is a wound that affects the very heart of the Church.

It means fewer shepherds to celebrate the sacraments, to administer Last Rites, to preach the Gospel, and to accompany God's people on their journey of faith. It means communities struggling to find spiritual guidance and support. It means souls thirsting for the grace and mercy of God, longing for the presence of a shepherd to lead them to green pastures and still waters. The need for priests has never been more urgent than it is today. Our parishes are crying out for men willing to respond to the call of the Good Shepherd, to lay down their lives in service to God's people. We must pray fervently for vocations, asking the Good Shepherd to send more shepherds to tend His flock. But prayer alone is not enough. Each one of us has a role in fostering vocations within our Church. We must encourage and support young men who may be discerning a call to the priesthood. We must create environments where vocations can flourish, nurturing a culture of discernment and openness to God's will. Do not be afraid to tell someone, "you would make a good priest." Dear parish family, let us also not be afraid to respond generously to God's call, let us open our hearts to His grace and allow ourselves to be guided by the voice of the Good Shepherd. For it is in answering His call that we find true fulfillment and joy, knowing that we are walking in the footsteps of the One who laid down His life for us.

As we offer our prayers on the World Day of Prayer for Vocations, let us pray for all those discerning their vocation, that they may have the courage to follow where the Good Shepherd leads. Let us also pray for an increase in vocations to the priesthood, religious life, and all forms of service within the Church, so that the love of the Good Shepherd may continue to be made known to all the world.

May the Good Shepherd, who laid down His life for us, guide us always along the path of discipleship, until we reach the eternal pastures of His kingdom. Amen

Baptism

Marriage

Primarily intended as prayers and anointing for healing from serious illness or as a spiritual preparation before surgery. Last Rites or Extreme Unction are for those in danger of imminent death.

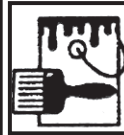
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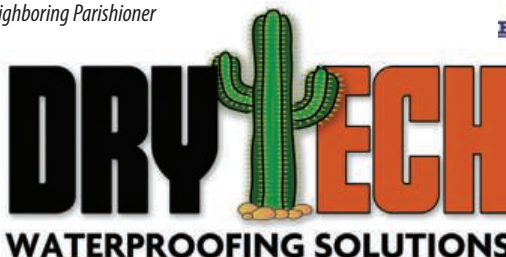
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
