



Mother's Day Mass Remembrance Cards



Dear St. Philip Neri Families & Friends



We give praise and thanks to God for the graces He has given us. Christ has risen, Alleluia. He has risen indeed. Alleluia. In today's readings we are presented with a beautiful tapestry woven with threads of love, friendship, and the universal call to salvation.

The Gospel passage from John and the excerpt from the Acts of the Apostles illuminate for us the profound truths of God's boundless love and His invitation to each of us to participate fully in His divine plan. In the Gospel of John, Jesus speaks to us about the essence of love. He tells His disciples, "As the Father has loved me, so I have loved you; abide in my love."

These words convey not only a commandment but also an invitation-a call to dwell in the deep, unending love that flows from the heart of God Himself. Jesus invites us into an intimate relationship with Him, a relationship characterized by love, trust, and mutual self-giving. He reveals to us the ultimate expression of love; laying down one's life for one's friends. But who are these friends of Jesus? In the Acts of the Apostles, we witness the unfolding of God's plan for the salvation of all peoples. The encounter between Peter and Cornelius, a Roman centurion, illustrates the universality of God's love and His desire for the salvation of every person, regardless of nationality, or background. Peter declares, "Truly I perceive that God shows no partiality, but in every nation anyone who fears Him and does what is right is acceptable to

Him." This revelation shatters any notion of exclusivity and expands our understanding of God's inclusive love. As we reflect on these readings, we are called to consider the depth of our own relationship with Christ and our response to His commandment to love one another. Are we abiding in His love, allowing it to permeate every aspect of our lives? Are we willing to embrace all people as brothers and sisters in Christ, recognizing the inherent dignity of every human person created in the image and likeness of God? My brothers and sisters, let us heed the words

of Jesus and abide in His love. Let us cultivate friendships rooted in the love of Christ, friendships that inspire us to lay down our lives for one another.

Let us embrace the universal call to holiness, extending God's love and mercy to all whom we encounter. In doing so, we participate in God's divine plan for the redemption of the world and bear witness to the transformative power of His love.
